That &%\$#@ Mirage!

Many new and seasoned shooters are intimidated when they sit down at the bench and look at their scope at their respective targets and see a blurred sight picture of mirage.

While many shooters view mirage as a minor or even a major hindrance in their ability to resolve the same aiming-point necessary to shoot good groups and aggregates, I believe with the right mindset mirage can be an extremely valuable wind-reading tool in conjunction to your flag-reading skill set.

When I started shooting Benchrest in 1998, I was very fortunate to be mentored by Perry Morton, a Hall of Fame member, and a good friend, whom has since passed away....

I can distinctly remember shooting the afternoon LV200 aggregate match at Holton Gun and Bow Club, in Holton Michigan, in July of '98.

As many whom remember the range at Holton, prior to its reconstruction in 2005, the original Holton range had much lower target frames and range made of almost entirely sand with very little grass. The combination of the lower target frames, field of sand and hot afternoon temperatures were the perfect storm of conditions; whereby no one could see the rings on their 200 yard targets, including Holton's range master! As a matter of fact, I can remember the range Master at Holton calling a cease-fire, due to the large number of competitors seeking his assistance to see if their sighters were hitting their respective targets!


I, too, had great difficulty in seeing any of my many shots on the sighter target. As I whined about how bad the mirage was and how could we possibly continue with the afternoon's LV200 agg. Perry Morton came to the rescue...


Perry pulled me aside during the long cease-fire and told me that in his experience, when the mirage was this bad at Holton, he would simply split the Target Square with his Vertical cross-hair and the split one of the black mirage stripes on the target frame with his Horizontal crosshair. Doubting Perry's advice, I pushed back and not so respectfully told Perry "There is no way I could resolve a small aim-point each time using his technique to shoot a good group". With great patience, Perry firmly responded I was repeating my same aim-point much more accurately than I realized by

holding my crosshair in the Target square and using the mirage board black stripe aiming points....

Perry also instructed me on the various sinewaves amplitude shapes... Essentially the larger the sinewave amplitude we see indicates slower wind speeds. Conversely, the smaller sinewave we see denotes faster wind intensity, much like a fast river of light...

During our cease-fire, I set-up






my scope on the Record target and then split the Target Square with my scopes vertical crosshair and then placed the Horizontal crosshair on one of the higher black mirage stripes opposite of the mothball, as he instructed, and when and only when the mirage would flow gently left-to-right, with a large slow-moving large sinewave, I should then start shooting my record group.

After many shooters returned from walking down to examine their targets first-hand to see if their sighter shots were actually hitting their targets, we returned to our benches and the match recommenced.

Doing as Perry instructed, I patiently waited looking through my scope at the Record target with the aim point Perry had recommended, the sinewave finally started to move slowly left-to-right. I started my group... Upon completion of my last record shot, I looked through my scope to see what I thought was a vertical group of six tenths or larger... When I turned around, I found Perry watching me shoot through his spotting-scope and give me a thumbs-up! Upon returning back to the bench to shoot our second match, Joe Freeman, whom was shooting next to me, informed me I had shot a .230" Scream group. Perry Morton was there to congratulate me and did not to miss the opportunity of reinforcing that we are repeatedly aiming smaller than we realize....even in heavy mirage!

One of the best uses of mirage. as a wind-reading tool, is when we encounter benign wind conditions at 200 yards. With no wind movement seen on the flags, when do you start shooting your group? Many will shoot a couple of quick sighters, hoping we catch an unforeseen good benign honest wind



condition allowing us to shoot a good group? Luck and hope are never good strategies to use as signals as to when we start shooting our groups....

When you encounter these benign wind conditions, predominantly at 200 yards, I would suggest trying to pick-up mirage movement in your scope. Many agree, shooting the "Boil" mirage, whereby there is stagnant wind, is normally to be avoided, as it can yield group "patterns" as the wind is in transition from moving in a consistent direction.



Most of the time, if you have a higher magnification scope of 40X+ magnification, you can pick-up the mirage moving in either direction. To prove the mirage is honest, as it usually is, shoot two sighter shots while the mirage is moving consistently in the same direction... I'll bet if your rifle is fairly tuned, you will see your sighter shots have doubled-up on top of each other. This should create your confidence in using mirage as a wind reading tool! Now, go to your record target and use the mirage tool, as you did on your sighter, and shoot yourself a little group! Using this technique will give you a distinct advantage over other competitors whom are hoping they chose a good time to try and shoot their group. Many times you will hear many competitors groan with their poor groups whom have ignored using this simple wind reading technique when the flags are completely calm.



Lastly, another great way to use mirage as a wind reading tool, is when you are shooting your group during light wind conditions. How many times over the years have you lost a shot out of your good group as one of your shots went into the condition? Upon losing this shot, you look up to see your flags starting to reverse in the opposite direction in accordance with the light wind that caused your lost shot out of the group. Grimm!

If you should you start your group in a light condition, be cognizant of the movement of the mirage. Make sure the mirage is moving with the direction of your wind flags! Should you start your group and you suddenly notice the mirage go to a Boil and/or reverse its direction, it's wise to put the brakes on and shoot a sighter or simply wait until the mirage reverses again in accordance with the wind condition you initially started group with.

I know the mirage we think we see through our scope is near the target, as that's where our scopes are focused. Many reading this article may refute my suggested use of using mirage as a valuable wind read-



ing tool as mirage does not show the wind angles, etc That's Ok ... I a call! would pose anyone whom may see mirage still as a detriment to go to your favorite practice range, setup some good practice targets at 200 yards, and try shooting some groups, using mirage as your only wind reading tool! You will be amazed of the small groups you can shoot, even on fairly windy days! Fred Hausecuster, a HOF member, and avid mirage shooter, used to tell me "Mirage is real-time wind that vou can".

Hope you will give these mirage tips a try! I believe they will help your group shooting!

Well "Mother Nature", fickle as she is, gave us mostly good weather this past weekend. 


Oak Hill Gun Club's NBRSA HV


