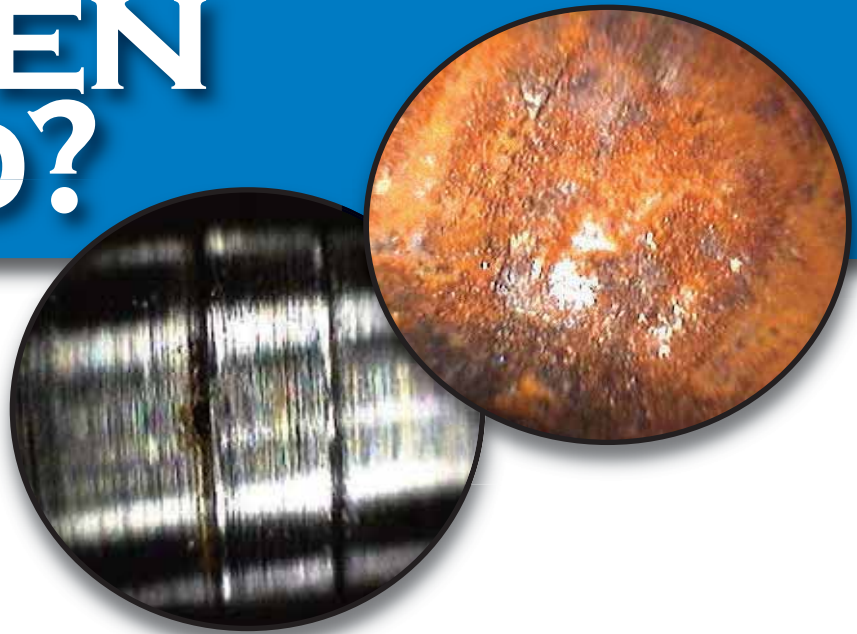

CHARLES HUCKEBA WINS TEXAS SHOOTOUT

Once again shooters converged on Midland Texas to challenge themselves in the tough West Texas conditions at the 2018 Texas Shootout. This year instead of the normal Light and Heavy Varmint rifles used in the Shootout, the Midland club will be hosting the Gulf Coast Regional Sporter, the Light Varmint rifle normally shot in this match was replaced this year with Sporter portion of the Gulf Coast Regional matches, the Heavy rifles would be making up the rest of the two gun this weekend.

Friday night after registration and practice, Ronnie Sewell invited the shooters to dinner at the cafe inside of the brand new Sewell Ford dealership in Odessa and treat everyone to a guided tour of the beautiful facility. Ron had a hard time getting the shooters out of the King Ranch Store inside the show room and a few of us from trying to steal the King Ranch custom lifted 4X4 show truck and into the dining room to eat! The nachos, pizza and salad was fantastic, Ronnie's son, Collin, did a great job preparing the food and I know that all those in attendance really appreciated the Sewell's hospitality.

When the shooters arrived early Saturday morning, they found the range to be a bit soggy from heavy thunderstorms coming through during the night. The air was thick with 90% humidity and temps in low 70's. With a very light but variable breeze out of the east, it was not your normal Midland shooting conditions.

Sporter rifles at 100 yards kicked off at 9:00 am. Kevin Downey took the first match handily with a tiny .068! The second match went to Gary Bristow's .141. Charles Huckeba moved into the lead with a .161 and Kelly Morman shot the small group of .125. Charles kept a hold of the lead by posting the small group .065 and followed up in the 5th match with a .110 to capture the Sporter 100 yardage with a .1384 agg! Great shooting Charles! Kevin Downey was second with a .2194 and Larry Baggett third with .2212.

After a short lunch break we moved on to the 100 yard Heavy Varmint matches. Joe Kubon shot a .143 in the first match to take the lead, Gene Bukys shot a .219 in the second match for small group but Tim Oltersdorf was now in the lead with his .225. Tim continued shooting well and followed up with a .263 in the third match to hold the lead, Mike Bryant shot the small group of the match with a .140. Midland shooter, Tom Brown jumped into lead after the fourth match with a nice little .156 small group. Gene Bukys was lurking near the top of the leaders and in the fifth group, his small group of .158 was good enough to overtake Tom for the win the Heavy Varmint 100 yardage. Gene's agg was .2324. Second place went to Larry Baggett's .2622 agg and Charles Huckeba was third with .2648. Throughout the day, wind continued to build in velocity and continued to be very swifty making it tough to get a good read Humidity only dropped down to around 40% and temps rose to mid-90's making it very hot and muggy, definitely not what you would normally expect to find in Midland this

time of year!

Sunday morning found the range very similar to the day before as far as wind, temperature and humidity goes. As you can imagine, lot of us thought we had the tune figured out and were going to shoot lights out today at 200 yards!

Joe Archer opened up Heavy Varmint 200 with a .334 to take the early lead after the first match. Gary Bristow answered him with a .301 to go into first place in match two. Charles Huckeba had the small group next with a .301 but Gary's lead was enough to kept out in front with a .434 he shot in the third match. In the fourth match Gary shot a .325 for another small group. Gary finished out the Heavy gun shooting a .502 to with the yardage with a .1954 agg. Mike Conry's .373 was the small group in the fifth and it was good enough to keep him in second place with a .2124 agg, just ahead of Charles Huckeba's third place agg of .2160.

The Sporter rifles came out once again to try at 200 yards. The winds had picked up only a little bit from the morning but with the humidity still high, any shifts in direction or wind speed hurt a lot if you didn't pay close attention to the subtle changes. Mike Conry started out with a small .322 group in the first match and Ron Sewell was second with a .403. Mike held the lead in the second with a .418 but Gary Bristow was hot on his heels with a .312 small group of the match. Gary overtook Mike for the match three lead with a .513 effort, local shooter, Rick Ellison shot a .305 for the small group in the third. Steve Murphy out of Lubbock moved into second place with a .352 group. Steve continued to ride his hot shooting gun and by the end of the fourth match, he had wrestled his way into the lead with a .573 target. Charles Huckeba was moving up in positions with the small group of the match with a tiny .291 group! Steve Murphy continued to dominate the field and clinched the win in the yardage with a finishing .589. This gave Steve a winning agg of .2544. Gary Bristow came in second with a .2639 and Charles Huckeba worked his way into third with another small group in the fifth match measuring .381 and a .2685 agg.

KOSTANICH WINS 3 STRAIGHT IN TACOMA

On June 2nd & 3rd the Tacoma Rifle & Revolver Club hosted the 2018 NW Regional HV/UNL-5 Andrews Memorial, where 11 shooters competed for top honors. This was the first half of the NW Regional 4-Gun and the second annual Andrews Memorial, named for brothers Denny and Bruce who were long time competitors in and contributors to the sport of bench rest shooting.

On Saturday morning HV-100 action began under sunny skies with 60 degrees and a light breeze. By Match 4 the wind had picked up and mirage was animating the targets. Lee Whiteley shot the smallest group of the morning at .114", and then nearly hung on for the aggregate too. But Steve Kostanich snatched the win with a .2028 and Lee had to settle for second with an enviable .2078 agg.

By afternoon the wind and mirage had strengthened as the temperature reached 72. In the HV-200, Larry Boers put together the winning aggregate of .2475, narrowly edging the .2479 posted by Jeff Lewis for second. Dan Kjelland shot the smallest group at .397". Steve placed third on the afternoon and with his earlier win, held on to take the HV Grand with a .2419. Larry was a close second, scoring .2438.

On Sunday morning we had mostly sunny skies with 55 degrees and some pretty good shooting conditions. In the UNL 5-200, Steve scored the smallest group at .168 but Larry won the yardage with a .1408 agg. Steve's .1511 agg placed second.

The afternoon's UNL 5-100 was contested in the same good conditions, although by Match 3 we were shooting in a light rain. Steve again shot the smallest group, at .078, and he also won the yardage with a .1290 agg. Jeff's .1416 agg was next best. By day's end, Steve had handily won the UNL 5 Grand with an even .1400, and Larry took second with a .1718.

With all 20 matches completed, Steve was declared the winner with a .1910 grand agg. And once again Larry was a near second, with a .2078. Steve has now won his third consecutive TR&RC 2-gun and, at mid-season, is making a strong case for Shooter of the Year.

All of our competitors express their appreciation for the efforts of Karen and Jim Lynn, Zach Silverton and Craig Kensler, who do all of the work to make the matches happen.

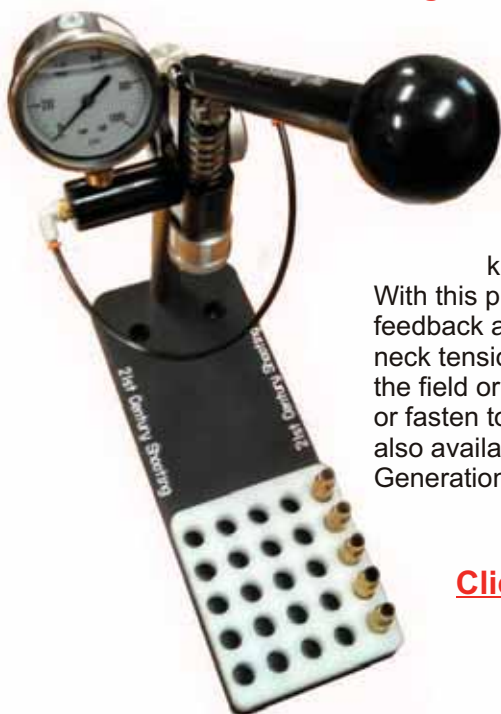

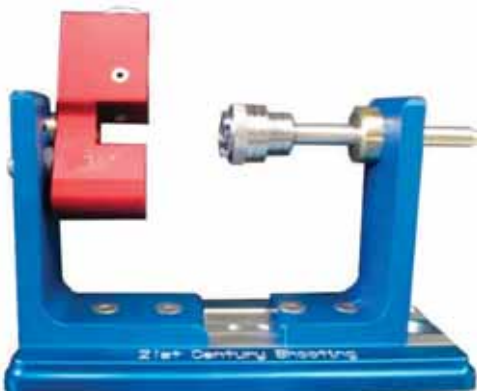
