



PROCEDURE FOR OFFICIAL RECOGNITION 600 & 1000 Yard WORLD RECORDS

Effective February, 2009

1. Targets must be signed by two officials. (Range Officer and/or Referees).
2. Match Directors will send:
 - 1 - Copy of Match Registration form
 - 2 - World Record Submission Form
 - 3 - Targets to the Regional DirectorThe targets must not leave the club grounds except in the possession of a Match Official, someone who did not shoot the record.
3. Regional Director after verifying:
 - 1 - Match Registration Form - with NBRSA competitor's number
 - 2 - NBRSA Sanctioned Match - with NBRSA Club number
 - 3 - World Record Submission Form
 - 4 - Targets signed by Match Officials - NBRSA membersRegional Director then sends all documents to the Record Measuring Committee Chairman.
4. The Chairman removes the range scores, measures the target, records the scores, assigns a number to each target and sends the target or targets to the first member of the measuring committee.
5. The committee member measures the target or targets, records the scores in his own records and on a measurement form. He then sends the form to the Committee Chairman and the target or targets to the next Committee member. When the last Committee member is finished he will send the form and target or targets to the Committee Chairman. In the case where a Committee member shoots a record an alternate measurer will be selected.
6. The Chairman then records the score of the Committee members, takes an average and that score is the Official measurement. He then notifies the Long Range Committee Chairman that a record has been set and returns the targets to the Competitor.
7. The Long Range Committee Chairman then notifies the Records Committee Chairman, the President, Business Manager and Magazine Editor.
8. The Business Manager then sends the Competitor a World Record Certificate and the Editor puts it in the Magazine.

Note: All record targets are to have only - 5 shots (light) - 10 shots (heavy) no sighter shots on record target.
