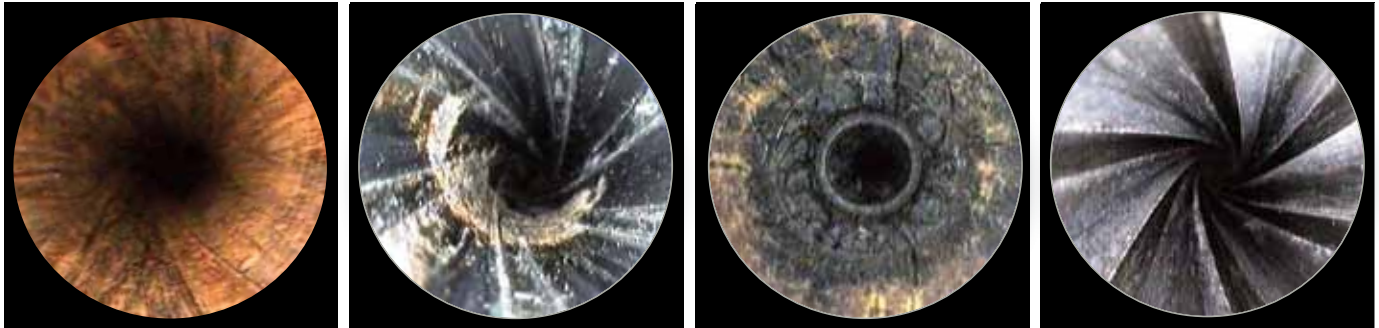

“Riders on the Storm” - Sahuaro July 14, 2018

We sat behind our guns waiting anxiously for the line to be called hot. Nervously switching our gaze from the lazy swaying of the downrange windflags, to the building thunderstorm to the west.

With impossibly black clouds, flashes of lightning and the billowing dust underneath it, it looked angry and we knew it was coming our way. It was definitely going to affect our shooting, but we just weren't sure how long it would be before it got here. The Arizona monsoon season was well un-

der way and for the last week there had already been a fair amount of rain in the southern Arizona desert. The air smelled fresh and clean and the vegetation was quickly turning so green it reminded me of Tanzania, East Africa. Between that and the humidity it seemed that the only thing missing to complete that image would have been a herd of Cape Buffalo meandering through the mesquite trees.

For the first three relays we were pretty lucky, the storm seemed to be in no hurry. Unlike

us! It took it's time and finally showed up to torment us for relay four. That's when the fun started. But I don't want to get ahead of myself.

There were an amazing 27 sub-MOA groups shot in Light gun for the day, and no less than 9 sub-MOA aggregates shot, some of which were in relay one but some of them in relay three as well. Four of the top shooters had all sub-MOA groups. Those shooters were Tony Gilkes, Wayne McDonald, Ross Herrick and Lon Person. Ross's first two

groups were both 7.9375". How's that for consistency. Following up with a 6.625" for a total agg of 7.50" earning him third place. Mike Billotte was second with a 7.27" aggregate which was shot in the third relay.

Lon Person showed us all how it's done by not only posting the smallest group in light gun with a 4.06" group but also winning first place with a very nice 5.98" aggregate.

In Light Gun Score it was Ed Schween easily in the lead with his 136-1X. Mike Billotte had the highest single target score of 49-3X plus the highest X count with 6 of them. Once again he did that when the winds were starting to pick up in relay three. Mike's 133-6X put him in second place and Wayne McDonald was right on his heels with a 132-1X.

Heavy Gun was mixed since part of it was shot in relay two and part in relay four. Relay two guys were lucky because the approaching storm was still taking it's time getting to us. You just never know what the conditions are going to do out here in the southern Arizona desert. I've seen many times when it will blow harder in the morning relays and then calm down for the later relays. It's totally luck of the draw.

Actually the threatening storm never did hit us, but it got close enough that by relay four the wind flags got so dazed and confused that they could never seem to decide which way to blow. To make matters worse, they could not even agree on which direction to point at any one time. That tends to make for some real Hail Mary wind calls and those can be frequently wrong. At least mine are.

But let's get back to the good news. There were seven sub-MOA groups, but only two sub-MOA aggregates turned in. Not surprisingly "Top Gun" Ross Herrick had not only all sub-MOA groups but also the smallest single target of 5.37" for a winning total agg of 7.33". Ed Schween was the other sub-MOA agg with a second place finish of 9.96" In Score it was Ross again, turning in all well centered targets for a 275 first place. But it was second place finisher Lon Person who had the highest scoring single target of 95-2X.

When the conditions turned ugly, there were three shooters (I'm sworn to silence on who they were), ended up with a total of 32 shots off target. That can happen all too often out here when mother nature decides to intervene in our fun. But that is part of the challenge. It just wouldn't be any fun if it wasn't difficult.

What a minute, did I actually say that? Okay.... Yes it would!

STEVE LEE WINS SE REGIONAL IN DUBLIN, GA. - JULY 28, 2018

Steve Lee wins 2018 SE Regional 200 Yard, Roger Avery wins HV 200

Not often I'm able to write "Steve Lee wins" but I did manage to pull off a win in Dublin.

Let me start by saying July in Dublin GA is HOT!!! I think we'll pass on future July shoots in Dublin.

This was the 200 yard stage of the Southeast Regional Championship and was held at the Middle Georgia Gun Owners Association (MGGOA) range in Dublin Georgia, home of the Shamrock. The 100 yard stage will be held October 6-7 at Roanoke Rifle and Revolver Club in Hardy Virginia.

Both mornings started with temps in high 70s and humidity over 90%. By 10 am temps were pushing 90 and by the end of shooting 95+ was the rule. Humidity did drop a bit during the day so at least it was a "moist heat". Every once in a while the flag tails would twitch, but the shooters didn't feel much of it. Everyone looked like a wet washrag by the end of the day.

Saturday morning in Unlimited 200 small group specialist Danny Morgan started out with .372. This was a 10 shot group with a bag gun! 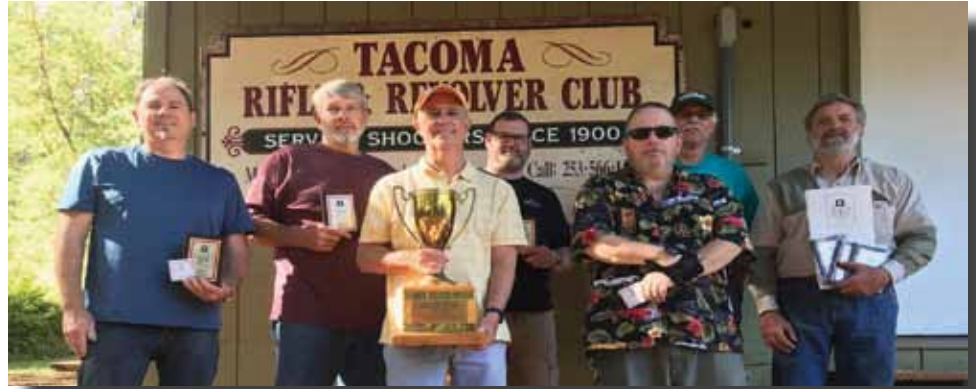

NW SNIPER KING/AGG KING/WILSON MEMORIAL - July 8, 2018

The Sniper King, the oldest active trophy in Benchrest, was awarded on July 7, 2018 to Steve Kostanich from Chehalis, Washington. Contested every year since 1944, the winner receives the trophy based on the smallest 10-shot group at 200 yard, in the Unlimited Class. Shooters have fifteen chances to win the coveted title. This year, Steve shot a .274" group to win the Sniper King Trophy for the third consecutive year.

The Agg King Trophy is awarded to the smallest aggregate of 10-shot groups at 200 yards, in the Unlimited Class. Shooters have three chances to shoot their best agg. Once again, the top honor went to Steve, who shot a .2252 to win the Agg King Trophy for the fourth consecutive year. Steve is having a fantastic 2018 season, with three 2-gun trophies already on his bench.

The Sam Wilson Memorial is awarded to the best 2-gun grand aggregate at 100 and 200 yards, in the Unlimited-10 and Unlimited-5 Classes. This year the trophy went to Gary Ocock, who shot a .2179 grand agg. In the past seven years, Gary has won the Sam Wilson six times, losing only to Steve in 2017.

On Friday, Gary won the Unlimited 10-shot with a .2619 grand agg. Jeff Lewis shot the 100 yard small group of .146", and the 200 yard small group was shot by Gary at .390". Saturday's Unlimited-10 Double-200 was won by Steve with a .2496. Steve shot both the morning and afternoon small groups of .274" and .314", respectively. And on Sunday, Gary won the Unlimited 5-shot with a .1738 grand agg. Larry Muller shot the 100 yard small group of just .078", and Doug Schwind shot the 200 yard small group of .218".

Fifteen shooters competed on Friday and Saturday, and twenty on Sunday which required two relays. All told, we had shooters from seven western states in attendance, including new shooter Emily Bowyer from Oregon. 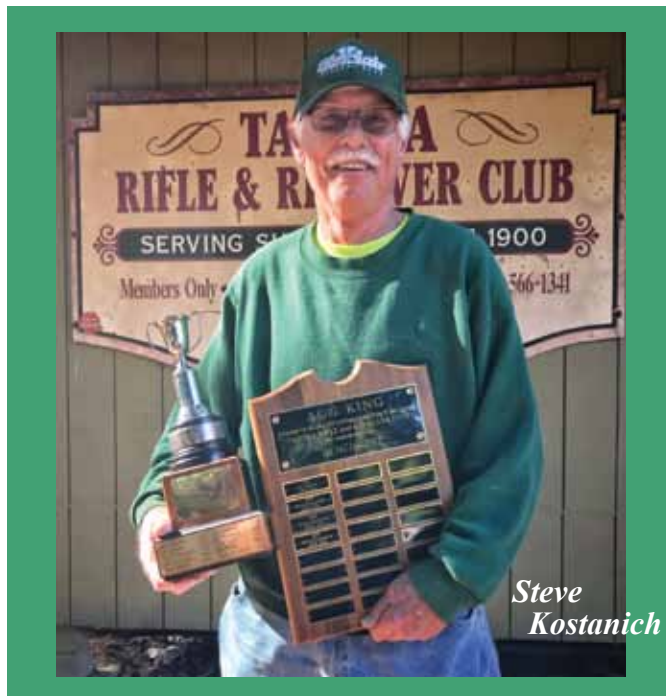

SAHUARO NBRSA MATCH JUNE 9, 2018

It was a windy day down in the southern Arizona desert. Have I mentioned that before? It can get windy out there. Nothing but a few sahuaro cactus and occotillo bushes to try to slow down the racing ghost of air, speeding across the desert.

It's soul purpose, at least in my mind, is to try to destroy the attempted accuracy that we try so hard to build into our rifles. With our building the best guns possible and then the best loads possible, our goals of shooting small groups and high scores can be so easily pushed around into bigger groups and smaller scores by that whistling nemesis.... the wind!

But then, we've been there before, done that, got the T-Shirt! (Literally). This day in June was no different. We once again went to battle with our nemesis. Who needs to worry about the other shooters on the line. It is the wind who we really have to compete against. Or should I say, it is ourselves and our ability to defeat the wind (or not).

Long range shooters dealing with the wind is getting to be an old story. In fact this is basically the same story, different day. It actually started out pretty good. Even though the wind had already gotten it's game on, the first relay stood up to it quite well. It was Wayne McDonald who led the way. He was way ahead of the other shooters in relay one. His groups of 4.75", 4.37" and even the not so great group of 10.62" (probably a one bullet flyer) gave him a nice 6.58" aggregate which put him in first place for light gun group.

The rest of us in relay one kind of muddled around like we weren't even there. In light gun group, while battling more wind, the relay three light gun shooters did a nice job with Pat Billotte turning in all sub-MOA groups to come in second with a 7.41" agg. And perennial winner Ross Herrick posting another all sub-MOA groups for an 8.35" aggregate to come in third.

Wild Bill Warner was the only other one in relay one to post all sub-MOA groups and had a 9.75" aggregate. Although for the day the first six shooters in light gun all had sub-MOA agg's.

It was a similar story in light gun score, with Wayne once again dominating the field with a 140-2X and scoring the only 50 score of the day to win not only highest single target but also the highest total score. Beating out second place by a full 9 points and he was the only one with any X's.

It shows what a factor the wind was when you see that all of the top scores in light gun were shot in the morning.

Moving on to heavy gun, the scores got lower and the groups got bigger, There were only two sub-MOA groups and no sub-MOA aggregates, but Ed Schween seemed to have a handle on the wind. His 11.63" thirty shot aggregate easily won

for heavy gun group, although it was Ross Herrick who, shooting also in relay four, shot the smallest ten shot group of 8.62".

In score, Lon Person handily defeated the wind (and the rest of us) by punching properly placed holes in the target for a winning score of 259-2X. And not surprisingly, he also had the highest single target score of 91-2X. Nice shooting Lon!

Super Dave Osborne was five points behind Lon for second with a 254-1X. You just never know how the conditions are going to treat you out here. But then again, it is how you treat the conditions that make the difference.

So while Wayne, Ed and Lon celebrated their

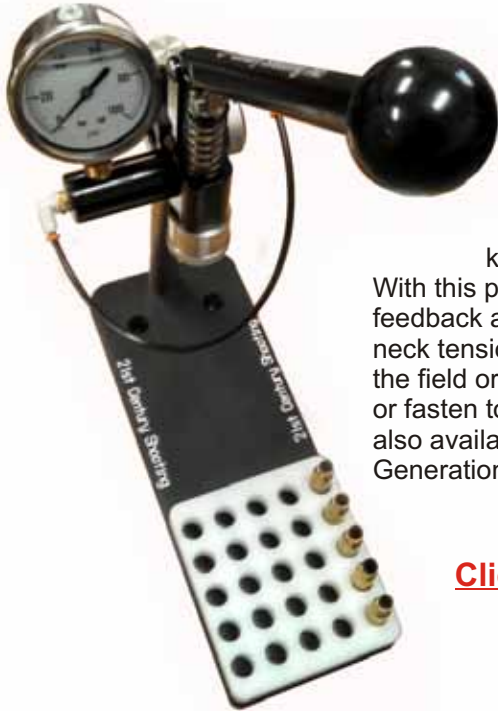

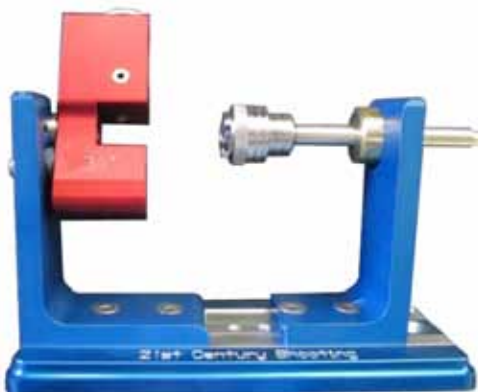
