


The opportunity to compete against and interact with shooters from all over the country and to test mysel against these top level competitors.

GUNS & GEAR

What rifle components do you use (Scope, Stock, Action, Barrel, Trigger)?

Currently I'm using two Borden BRMXD actioned rifles in Wheeler/McMillan LRB stocks with Jewell triggers. These both carry Krieger 4 groove, 10 twist HV barrels chambered in 300WSM. I'm using Vortex Golden Eagle 15-60 scopes on both and the rifles are essentially clones except for weight. The HG weighs 27lbs vs the LG weight of 17lbs.

Greatest Accomplishment:

I had set four NBRSA world records when I was shooting previously...LG Agg in 2008, and all three possible Highest Three Target Score records in 2010, two of which still stand. The first was probably the most satisfying as was my performance in the 2010 Nationals where I placed high in several categories and was Heavy Gun Champion for Score.

Any advice you would share with new shooters?

Make a committment to excel at whichever discipline you choose. Get the best equipment and components that you can afford and consider each match a learning experience. At some point anything that can go wrong will go wrong and one must learn from these mistakes. Most importantly, be patient and keep coming back. In Arizona good shooting conditions are rare. You gotta be in it to win it and if you show up at every match you can attend eventually a great condition will appear on your relay and you'll have a chance to mark a spectacular score.



Why Did My Rifle Quit Shooting?

Has this ever happened to you?

Many times I have had my BR rifle with a new barrel shooting very, very well during a past BR Group match and also during a few practice sessions. However, during my next match, my rifle will no longer produce little tiny groups?

To try and resolve this frustrating issue, I have tried going up and down in powder charges, with no improvement in my rifles performance.

I have also thoroughly cleaned my barrel to ensure it wasn't powder/copper fouled to no avail...

My rifle just quit shooting small groups.

When my barrel was new, I did my duediligence in spending the necessary time to properly tune my rifle to identify the best seating-depth for the given bullet I would be using.

I keep careful notes on the group shapes/sizes the different seating-depths would produce. The chosen seating depth I used was proven to work extremely well for the first 100-200 rounds on the barrel...

Alas, in frustration, I decided to try to make a change by lengthening my seating depth (lengthening the cartridge case-head to ogive measurement) by only .003" longer.

Wow...! This small .003" change snapped my rifle back into tune and returned my rifle back to its previous great shooting form!

It's my humble belief, especially with a new rifle barrel, that as a barrel begins its initial throat erosion, your seating depth may need to be slightly lengthened to account for barrel (throat) wear.

Over the years, I have made this seating-depth correction many, many times and thus fixed my rifle's tune during match.

This small suggested seating depth change has also helped many shooters return their rifles to great shooting glory!

Give this seating depth "fix" a try, if your barrel begins to lose its edge and changing your load has not yielded any improvements... You'll be glad you did!







