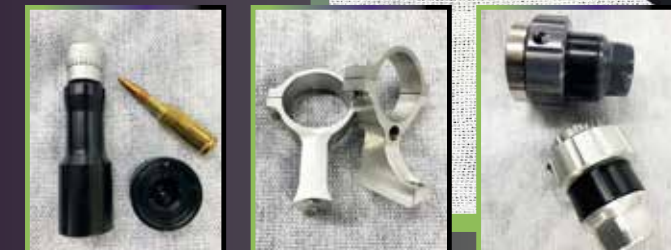

# 2021 600/1000 YARD NATIONALS

October 18 - 23, 2021 -- Sloughhouse, California

Results Received: 11/2/2021

The 2021 Long Range Southwest Region Nationals was held this year in Sloughhouse, California. The event was a 4 day match scheduled for October 18th - October 23rd, 2021, requiring shooters to compete at 600 and 1000 yards.

Competitors started arriving the day before the actual match to get their rifles sighted in and to work up any last minute loads in preparation for the anticipated challenge of competing with some real experienced shooters. As each day was completed reality set in that anything less than shooting your best probably wouldn't be enough.

The overall number of shooters was a little less than expected because of the projected weather issues, but the match drew some competitors that have been competing for years and they were ready to put their skills to the test against other experienced shooters. All of the competitors quickly found out that if they wanted their name listed in the top positions and rankings they would have to contend with cold weather, wind gust up to 15 mph, and rain, all within a few days. There were periods throughout the day when the sun did come out, but unfortunately it brought a mirage with it.

On day 1 of the 600 yard match the weather started off chilly with temperatures in the 50's eventually reaching the high 60's by the end of the match. On day 2 the weather was unpredictable with occasional sprinkles. At the end of day 2 the forecast for the rest of the week showed mild to heavy rain so a decision was made to move the 1000 yard match up a day. As anticipated, it started raining on the first day of the 1000 yard match and some light rain carried over to day 2 of that match. However, that didn't stop our competitors from posting some fantastic scores considering they were shooting in a light rain at 1000 yards at times.

Even though the weather wasn't kind to the competitors, you couldn't tell by the scores posted in the results.....

4th place Wallace Laursen; 5th place Greg Wilson.

4th place Bill Johnston; 5th place William Hubina

Overall top shooters for the 600 and 1000 yard combined scores were as follows:

1st place and Grand Champion, Jeff Locke; 2nd place Wallace Laursen; 3rd place Joe Cerami; 4th place Keith Faller; 5th place Ted Rea; 6th place Bruce Teel; 7th place Bill Johnston; 8th place Craig Mathew; 9th place Rick Duncan; 10th place Bruce Bangeman.

We'd like give a special thanks to all of the volunteers that pitched in to make this event a success. Unfortunately our Match Director was unable to run Nationals this year so we want to thank him for the all the hard work he did this year and we look forward to his participation for the remainder of the year. We especially want to acknowledge the volunteers from Oregon, Bill Johnston and Jeff Locke for coming down and really taking a lead role in coordinating this event. This year we were fortunate to have a special attendee, Jack Neary NBRSA President, who not only attended the match but also helped out in the pits with the targets and provided lunch for everyone, Thank you Jack.

Again, a special thanks goes out to our long list of volunteers that helped out with everything from clean-up to scoring the targets and serving food. It goes without saying that without active members that believe in team work none of this would have been possible.

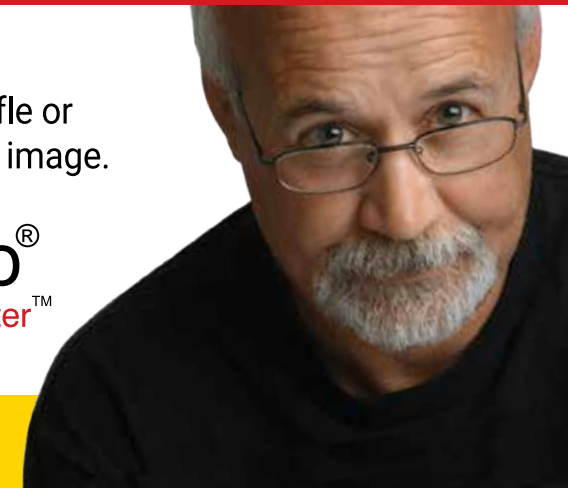

How do you determine who is the 600/1000 National Champion?

After 2 days of shooting, we combine (aggregate) Day 1 and Day 2 results to crown National Champions in each of the following categories:

- Light Gun Group\*
- Light Gun Score\*
- Heavy Gun Group\*
- Heavy Gun Score\*
- 2-Gun Group
- 2-Gun Score

The National Champion for the yardage (600 or 1000) is determined by assigning point values based on the shooter's placement in the 4 LG/HG Categories denoted above with \*.

The shooter with the lowest placement points total is crowned the 2021 600 Yard National Champion. This process is repeated for the 1000 yard match to determine the 1000 Yard National Champion.

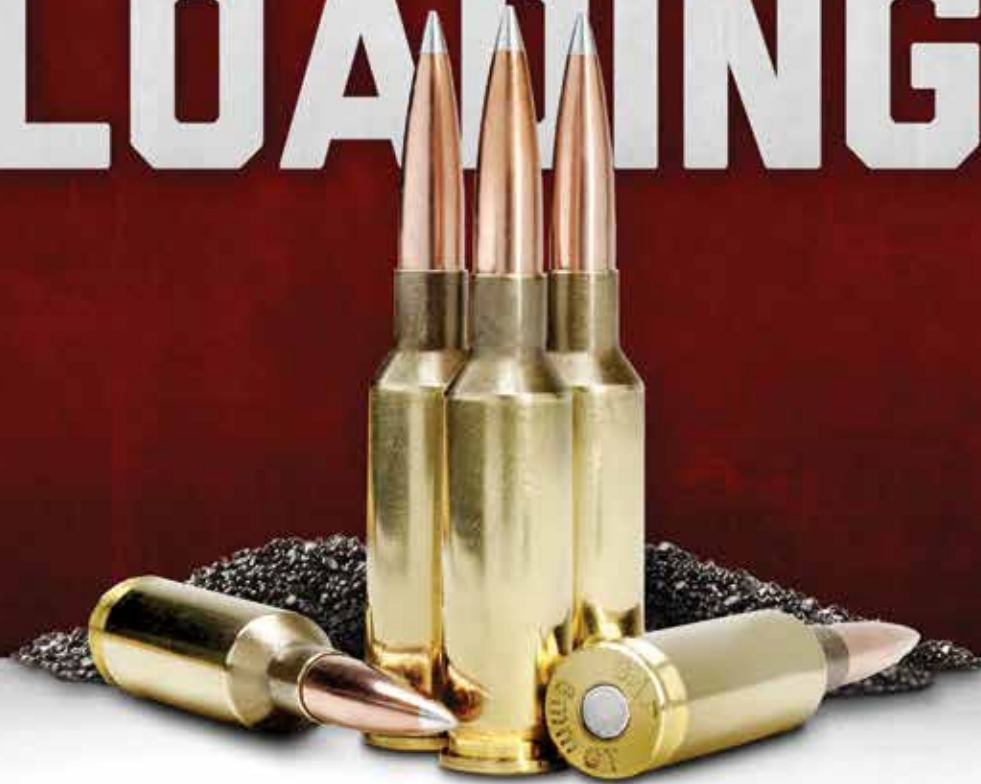

It was near impossible to get a five shot string off without having several different conditions. Sunday they calmed down to something much more manageable but as the day progressed they did kick up a bit.

Saturday started off with 100LV and only Dean Ekstrom and Greg King managed to get a handle on those switchy winds as they stayed well ahead of the rest of the pack. It ended up with Dean in 1st, Greg in 2nd and Dave Coots taking the third place honors. Dean somehow managed to shoot a .137 for a small group. 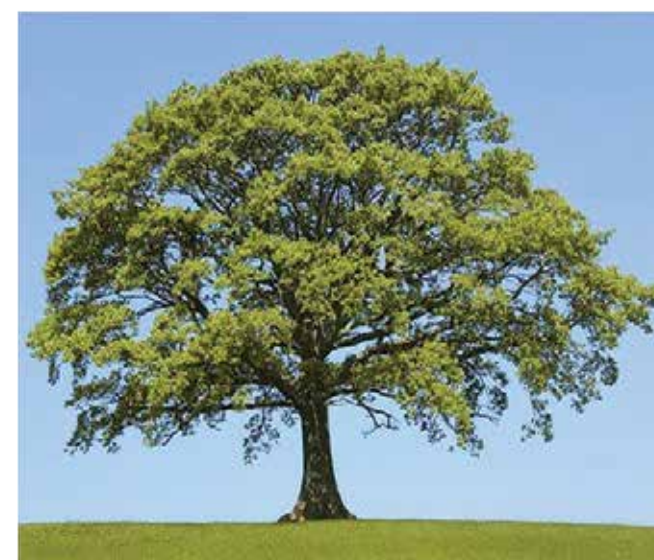

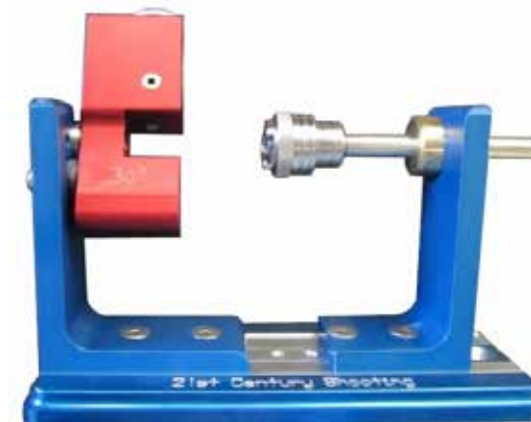
