How do you determine who is the 600/1000 National Champion?

After 2 days of shooting, we combine (aggregate) Day 1 and Day 2 results to crown National Champions in each of the following categories:

- Light Gun Group*
- Light Gun Score*
- Heavy Gun Group*
- Heavy Gun Score*
- 2-Gun Group
- 2-Gun Score

The National Champion for the yardage (600 or 1000) is determined by assigning point values based on the shooter's placement in the 4 LG/HG Categories denoted above with *.

The shooter with the lowest placement points total is crowned the 2021 600 Yard National Champion. This process is repeated for the 1000 yard match to determine the 1000 Yard National Champion.




