## Shooter of the Month | Joe Kubon - Wylie, TX

Joe has been the guy behind the scenes in the Gulf Coast region shooter of the year program. For the past 10 years or more, he's been keeping up with the points won from each group match for the year to determine who wins the Shooter of the Year at the end of the years shooting season. Joe became involved in benchrest shooting like most of us through a friend. Joe liked to shoot and about 20 to 22 years ago, Butch Lambert asked Joe to fire-form some brass for him shooting one of Butch's benchrest rifles. It shot so accurately fire-forming, that Joe decided that he had to get one of these rifles and wound up buying a used benchrest rifle. Joe has always been technically minded as he was an engineer with Rockwell before he retired. Joe's first registered match was at the Tomball, TX gun club. When he started shooting benchrest, he bought a small lathe and has done his own barrel work from just about when he started. His favorite range to shoot is Seymour, TX. He feels it's an honest range and the only time it gives him fits is when the wind is over his shoulder from the SE. Seymour has always been the "big gun" capitol of Texas. The first registered match they held there was the unlimited class and they have held at least one big gun match a year every year sometimes 2 except for 2020 when their match schedule was canceled due to Covid. Anyone who has an interest in shooting the UL class needs to put Seymour on their bucket list. The Texas State UL will be shot at Seymour, June 5th with the HV class shot on the 6th. The rail gun is one of Joe's favorite classes to shoot except that now it's getting a little too heavy to put on the bench and he may switch to a bag gun for UL. At 83 years of age, Joe is looking forward to the 2021 benchrest season and plans to shoot every match. Joe said it best "I just like to shoot!"

# SOUTHWEST REGION

Covid-19 Open @ Ben Avery Shooting Facility  
October 3-4, 2020

The NBRSA Group shooting season in Arizona started off in October with a bunch of uncertainty. At the Ben Avery range we have a benchrest match each month during what is Fall and Winter for the rest of the country. We have 7 matches October through April, with March being the Biggie, the Cactus Classic. As was the case our October match weather was very much like the 5-6 weeks preceding. High temps for the practice days and match days were at or over 110. In addition the winds were moderate and switching quickly. It was very difficult to maintain a competitive attitude while trying to overcome the shooting conditions. Match attendance was off about 50% (16 shooters registered) not only because of the forecasted weather but everyone was concerned about the Pandemic. The match operation however went off as usual; just fine. We are lucky to have people running the match who know what they are doing and go about it like wise.

The match was a LV-HV and we started off Saturday morning with the Light Varmint 100. Winning the aggregate was Jack Childers shooting a nice .2436. In second place was Steve Berg with a .2888 and third place was Dana Andrus with a .3048. Small group was a .182 fired by Steve Berg in match #2. Of note relatively new shooter Paul Perosky Jr finished in 4th place shooting his own bullets.

After a break for lunch we shot the Heavy varmint 100. Officially winning the aggregate was Gary Ocock shooting a .2830. In second place was Pete Savage with a .2930 and finishing third as he did in the morning LV agg was Dana Andrus with a .3002 aggregate. Actually the shooter who shot the best aggregate was Jack Childers with what would have been a .2612. However the rule book states that when you shoot your entire group on another target you earn a 5inch penalty. I mentioned earlier about the heat and how hard it was to concentrate; my guess is the heat got Jack.

Interesting is Jack picked up a Bartlein barrel on Friday at the match. He fire formed brass late Friday afternoon with no flags near his bench. When he was done he came over to me and said the barrel is a shooter; judging by what would have been 2 first place finishes it looks like he got a winner. Small group for the yardage was a .132 fired by Jack (cross fire) Childers in match 4.

Sunday we shot the 200 yard stages starting off with the Heavy Varmint. Shooting conditions were a tad better Saturday as the wind wasn't switching as fast and if you were paying attention you could pick it up and not get hurt too bad. It was easy though to shoot on auto pilot as it was hard to fight the heat and concentrate.

Winning the yardage was Dana Andrus, the only shooter to shoot a two agg with a .2874. In second place was Gary Ocock with a .3010 and in third place was Chuck Miller with a .3197. Small group for the yardage was a .332 fired by Gary Ocock in match #3. In looking over the stats I saw something that very rarely happens at Ben Avery; match #3 all of the shooters shot under an inch, in fact everyone was under .900.

We took a short break and shot the Light 200. Because of the heat 4 shooters had their fun for the weekend and took off. It was understandable as it was uncomfortable try to shoot competitive groups in 110+ temps. Winning the aggregate was Bob Brackney with a .3260. In second place was Gary Ocock with a .3279 and in third place was Hector Elias Jr. with a .3308. Those were the only aggregates under .4 for the yardage. Small group was shot By Hector Elias Jr. a .402 in match #1. Not a whole lot of drama in this agg. I think everyone just wanted to get it over with.

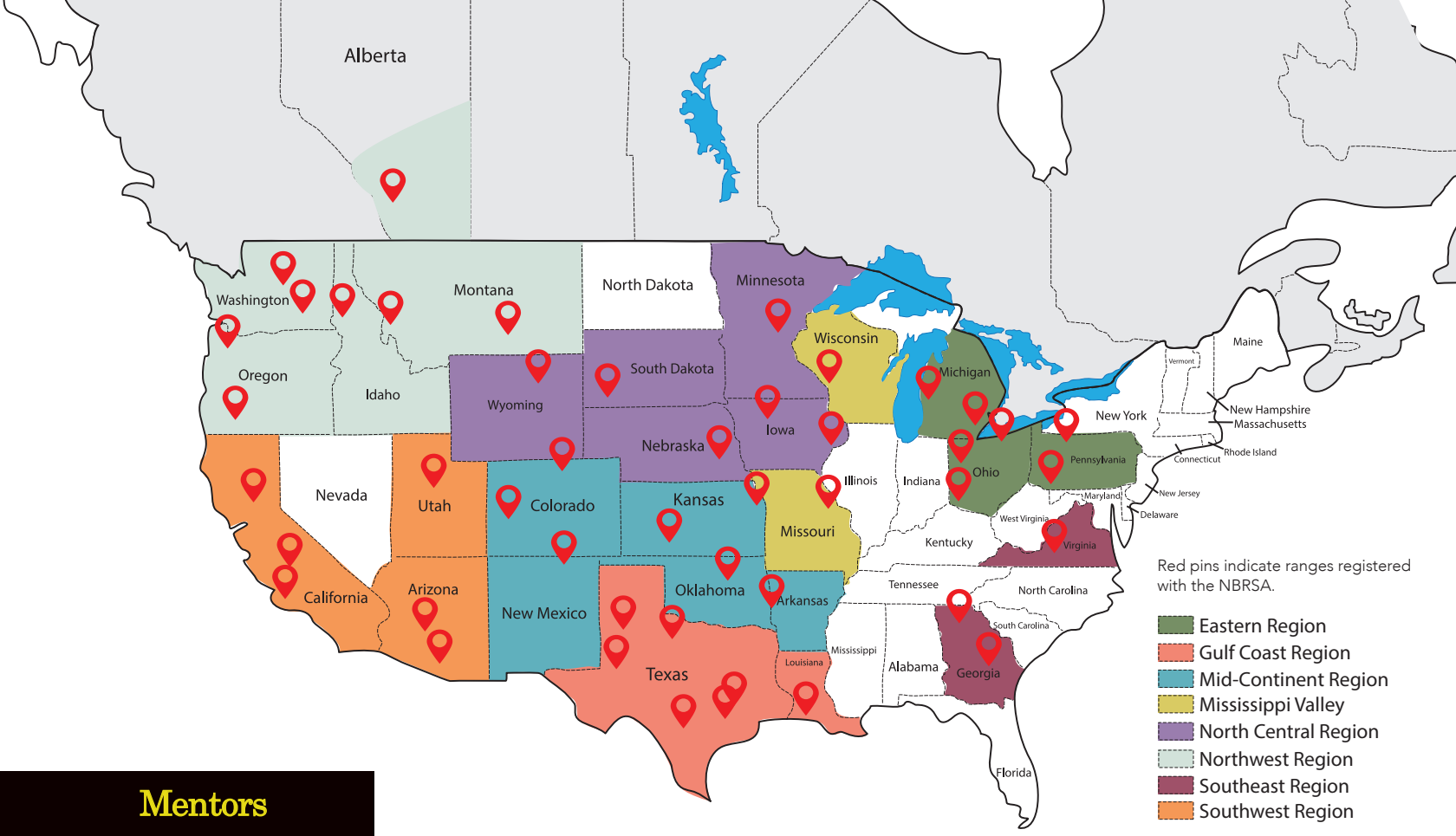

I would like to thank everyone that helped put on the match. It takes a lot of great people working together to make it happen.

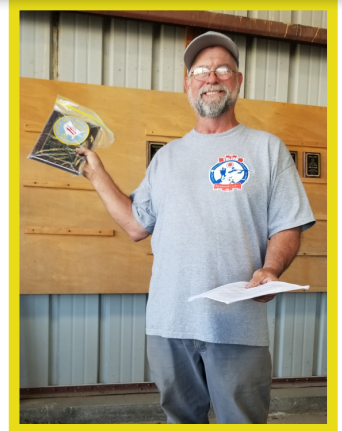

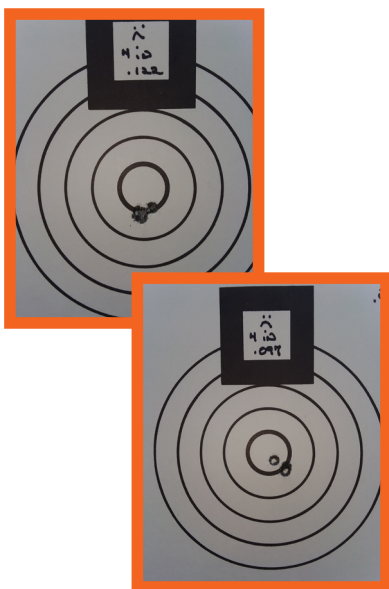

Middle Georgia Gun Owner's Association in Dublin, Georgia, hosted the 2020 NBRSA Southeast Regional Championship, October 30 through November 1, 2020. The Southeast Region Championship is a 4-day, 4-gun shoot with Unlimited and Sporter classes shooting on Thursday and Friday, followed by Light Varmint and Heavy Varmint on Saturday and Sunday.

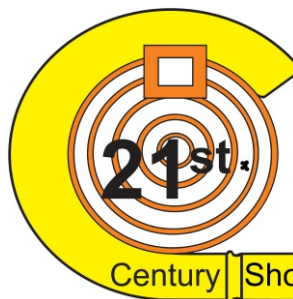

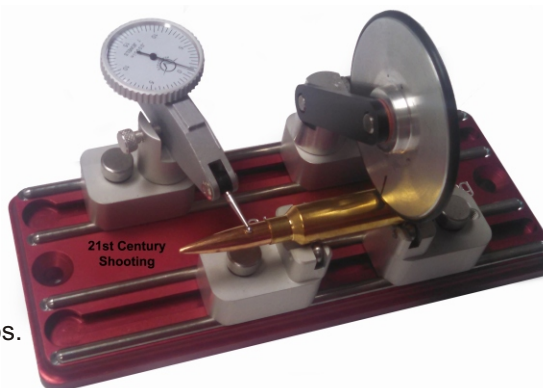

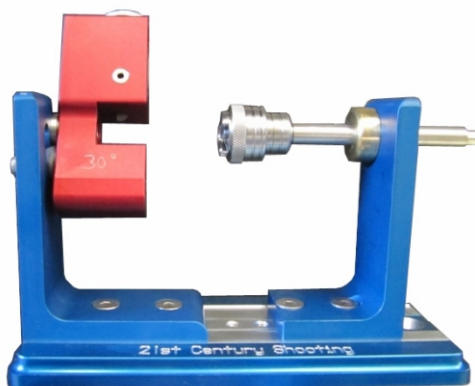
