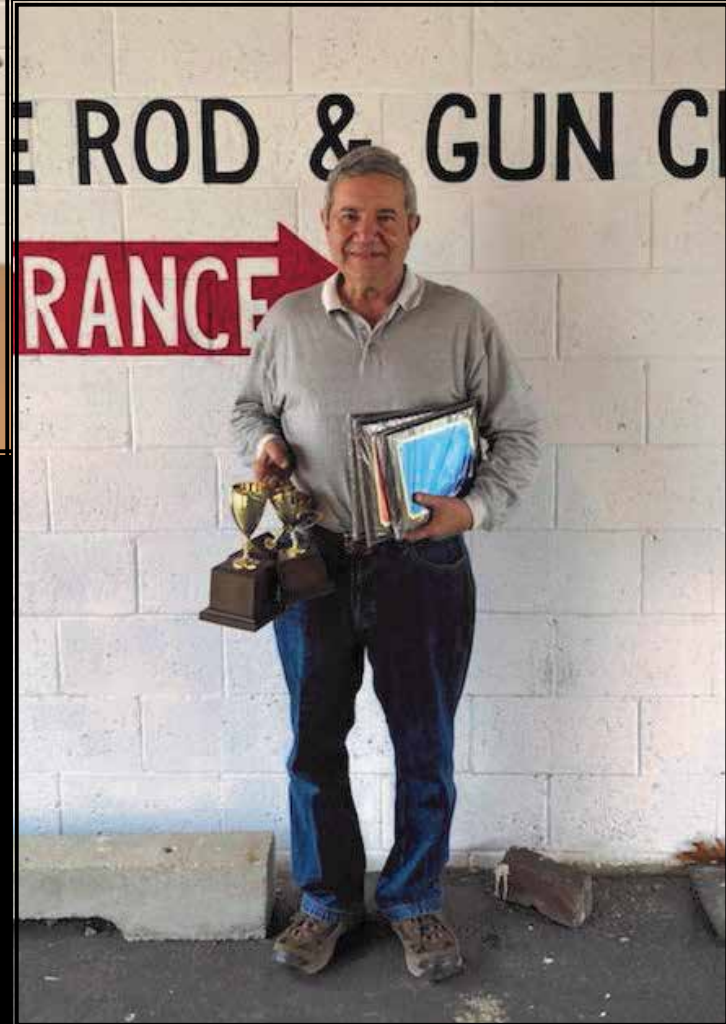

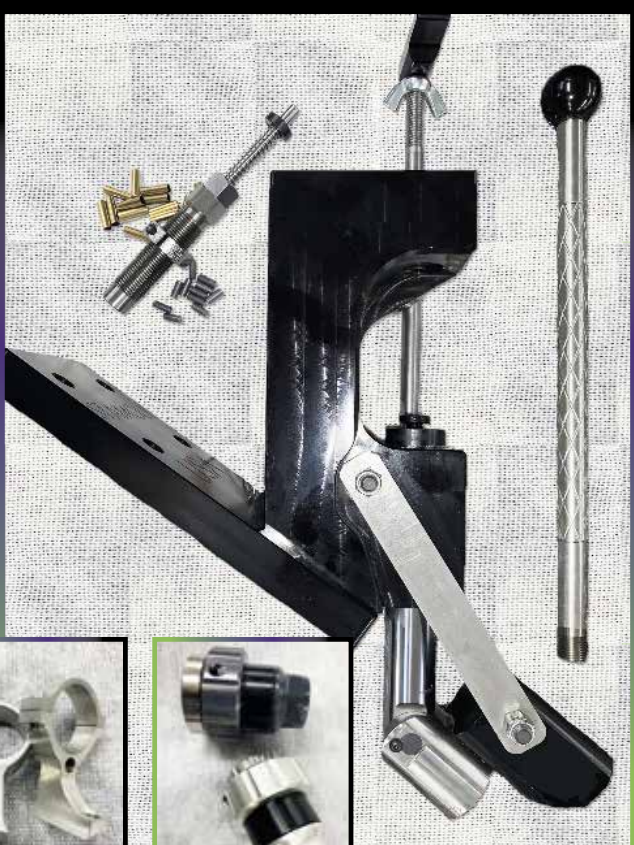

2021 HOG ROAST

March 15, 2021 - Fairchance Rod & Gun Club, PA

Results Received: 5/9/21

We had a fine turnout of 70 shooters, representing at least 7 states, with a solid mix of Hall of Fame shooters added as well.

Friday's practice proved to be a reasonable indicator of the match conditions on Saturday for the 100 yard stages. Conditions were quite cold and the wind was relentless. On Saturday morning as the relays got started it was obvious that the smallest groups were not going to approach any records. There were very few "ones" shot at all, and only one "zero group" was recorded. Kevin Donalson Sr. scored a .099 in the first match for small group, and helped him toward a fourth place finish in Light varmint 100.

Handling conditions best for the light varmint win was veteran Fairchance regular Wayne Utchell with an agg of 0.2140. Larry Costa followed with a 0.2168, and in third was Paul Mitchell, firing a 0.2216.

The afternoon session of Heavy Varmint brought slightly warmer weather, but still challenging wind conditions. Once again, only one "zero group" was fired. That was a fine 0.098 by Paul Mitchell. At the end of the afternoon the standings were: Paul Mitchell (1st) with a 0.2186 agg, Pat Metcalf (2nd) with a 0.2210 agg and Larry Costa (3rd) with a 0.2244.

Sunday brought warmer weather, but in some ways even more challenging winds. Higher speeds and complete reversals in direction were the norm. Shooters handling conditions best for the H.V. 200 morning session were: Larry Costa (1st) with a 0.2540 agg, Paul Mitchell (2nd) with 0.2547, and Jeff Peinhardt (3rd) with a 0.2562, creating a top three with only a 0.0022 spread.

Sunday afternoon 200 L.V. was perhaps the most challenging agg. of the weekend. Wayne Campbell claimed first with a 0.3128 agg. Dana English followed with a 0.3198, and third was Kevin Donalds Jr. with a 0.3229.

In the Grand Aggregate for Heavy Varmint, the winner was Paul Mitchell with 0.2367, second place was Larry Costa with .2392, and third was held by Jeff Summers with .2470. Larry Costa won the Light Varmint Grand Aggregate with .2809, second was Jeff Summers with .2816, and third was Jeff Peinhardt with 0.2876. Another very close variation only .0067 over the first three placings.

Overall 2-Gun winner for the Match was Mister Consistent, Larry Costa with 0.2601. Second was Jeff Summers with an agg of 0.2643, and third was Paul Mitchell firing 2 days at 0.2667. Great shooting guys!

Shooters would like to thank the Fairchance Club for putting on a fine match, Jerry Van Sickle and his entire crew /staff have continued the "Hog Roast" tradition as one of the NBRSA's top regional matches.

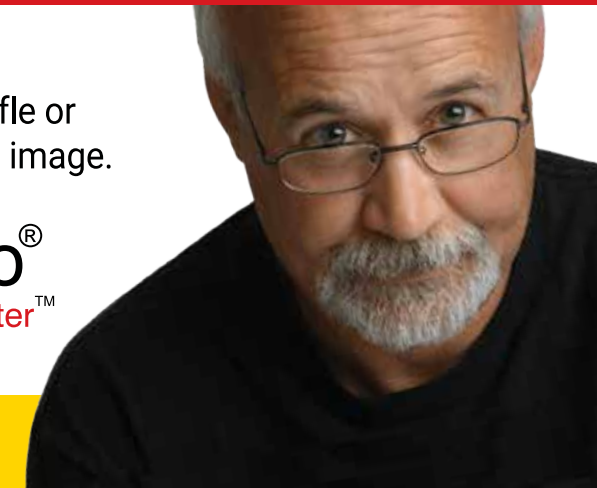

2021 CACTUS CLASSIC

March 13-14 2021 - Ben Avery Shooting Facility, AZ

Results Received: 5/3/21

The match started off with 5 days of practice if you wanted it. Unfortunately if you wanted to test loads, barrels etc. in easy conditions you were out of luck. If you wanted to test/practice in challenging conditions this was the week. The Ben Avery facility mandated that the match could go on with a few Covid restrictions. The match was limited to 90 competitors, we had 70 show up. We were required to use every other shooting bench so we used even numbered benches and 3 relays. No dinner for the shooters prior to the match and no food served at the range. Awards were presented at the range, outside rather than indoors. The restrictions significantly impacted the Cactus program. However, I feel that staff and competitors made the best of a tough situation and the match went off with few hiccups. Weather conditions Wednesday through Friday – the days most of the competitors practiced.

It was common for competitors during practice sessions to complain about not being able to get any consistency with their loads. There were as always a few who had their rifles and loads working well.

Match day Saturday 3-13. We started off with the Light Varmint 100 yards. Temperature 45-60, Wind 7-15 mph, Max wind 24 mph, Humidity 33-69%, Cloudy with patches of sun. Having lived in Arizona for 30+ years I got used to the heat. Maybe it's my age but I thought the weather for the weekend match was one of the more uncomfortable matches I've attended in a long time. At times I had on 5 layers on clothing. In conversations with other shooters the feeling was mutual.

Off to a fast start was Greg Smith shooting a .092 in match #1, small group for the yard-age. In that match there were only 13 one's shot and next closest was a .142. Ed Adams who has been shooting Ben Avery very well the last few years won the Light Varmint 100 Yard Cactus Aggregate with a very good .1796, beating Lester Bruno by 30 thousands. Ed shot 4 one's and a low two for his win.

Saturday afternoon we shot the 100 yard stage of the Heavy Varmint class. By this time the shooting conditions were a challenge for most of us. Winning the Heavy Varmint 100 Yard cactus Aggregate was Lester Bruno with a very nice .2012; beating John Verhagen by 27 thousands. Helping Lester to the win is a .088 shot in match #3. I was not shooting

very well this day and shooting next to Lester, at times I would watch Les shoot his group thinking maybe I could learn something in regards to the conditions. Often I would shoot

early in the match and then look over and watch Les shoot or finish his group. Match #3 when Lester shot a .088 I watched him put his 3rd shot into the group and then he stopped and waited for nearly 3 minuets before finishing the group. What amazed me was after waiting all that time he didn't fire a sighter shot before putting the 4th and 5th shot into the group. I later asked him about it and he said he knew where the shots were going in various conditions; the condition he wanted came back and he went for it. To do that, you have to have everything working really well and have a ton of confidence.
