2021 MICHIGAN STATE CHAMPIONSHIP

July 31 - August 1, 2021 -- Holton, Michigan

Results Received: 8/30/2021

The conditions on Saturday morning for the 100 LV was typical of a July/August day in Michigan. Temperatures were cool at 55 degrees and the humid was high at 84%, and the winds were testy from the Northwest. Getting your load right was challenging as the temps moved up and the humidity dropped through noon. Figuring it out correctly, was Victor Potts who shot a nice.2024. In second place was Dale Dillingham with a .2218 and in third was Kip Jones with a .2240. In the afternoon for the 100 HV, temperatures started in the 80's and moved up and the humidity continued to fall into the mid 40's. The winds picked up a lot. Victor Potts continued his dominance with a nice .2078 agg to win again. Second place this time went to Bob Hawkins with a .2164 and third went to (you guessed it) Kip Jones with a .2380.

On Sunday morning for the 200 HV, we had windy conditions with temperatures around 70 degrees and the normal morning high humidity. The winds were brisk from the southwest with hard switches which required utmost attention. By lunch time, the mirage kicked up into high gear. The best conditions wind-wise, had the most difficult mirage.

So, you had to choose between seeing the rings on the target or shooting the stiff winds. Winning the agg in the morning was my left-handed bench partner Steve Tuner with a real nice .2617 (as I said, tough conditions!). Coming in second and third was Ted Heindselman with a .2928 agg and (wait for it...) Kip Jones with a .2992 agg.

On Sunday afternoon for the 200 LV the conditions were about the toughest I've seen at Holton in 21 years of shooting benchrest. The mirage and switching winds made it a challenge for all. I couldn't handle it trying to shoot heads up. However, those that could pick their way through the seven-minute match did well. Coming in first place was Ken Hottenstein with a .2701 agg. In second was Dominic Grunas with a .3042, and in third was (...you guessed) Kip Jones with a .3106.

The Heavy Varmint Grand was won by Kip Jones with a .2673. The Light Varmint Grand was won by Ted Heindselman with a .2666.

The 2-Gun was won by Kip Jones with some fine shooting and focus on all four aggs (which many struggled with). Considering the conditions at Holton, Kip shot an outstanding agg of .2680. Ted Heindselman also shot well, and finished second with a .2947 agg 2-Gun. In third was Steve Turner with a .3091. Fourth and fifth when to Lee Hachigian and Dominic Grunas.

I'm not sure if fun was had by all this weekend, but it was nice to see Pancho Garcia and John VanMid-delkoop.

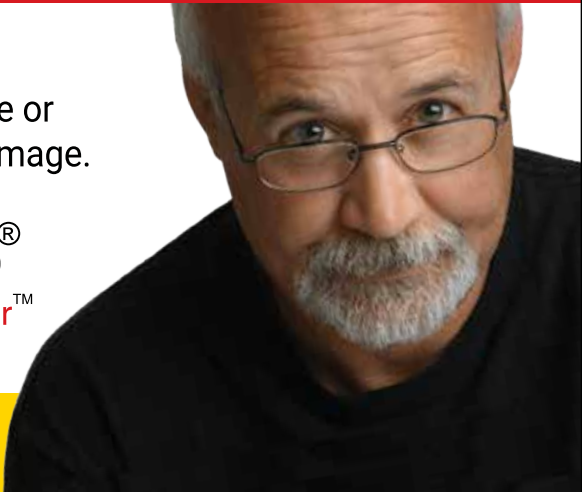

MONTANA STATE CHAMPIONSHIP

August 28-29, 2021 -- Billings, Montana

It was a dark and stormy night... that was Friday evening as folks gathered for the August 2021 LV/HV Championship at the Yellowstone Rifle Club in Billings, Montana. Not much practice was happening as Mother Nature sent swirling black clouds and the ominous threat of rain. The weatherman said tomorrow would be better, so we set up the benches and hunkered down as it rained throughout the evening.

Saturday morning air was still thick with a rare-for-Montana humidity for as Justin Young cooked up a powder charge for the Light Varmint 100 with small groups on the first three targets. He was well on the way to an even rarer Yellowstone teen agg with a .166, .196, .210, and .208 before the fifth target (.316) anchored the win with a very respectable .2192. The mild conditions were slipping away but not too much for new shooter Pat Auer to steal the coveted small group ball cap with a nice .154 on the fourth match. The rest of the field was in the .3+s with Ron Powell's .3164 barely edging out Paul Holland's .3166 for second and third.

The afternoon saw continued mild conditions but with enough Yellowstone switchy-ness to make everyone scratch their head. This time it was veteran score shooter Ron Powell who start out giving us lessons. Ron has just recently joined us for the group events and his .119 on the first match earned him a small group hat. He followed it a second small group .230 and looked to repeat Justin's morning but it was Rod Brown who found a condition and finished with three small groups to take the HV 100 agg with a .2328. Patrick Auer was again showing that he had an eye for these twitchy conditions, taking second with a .2792, and Billings area regular Dave Hellekson claimed third with a .2956.

A few thunderstorms passed through the area Saturday evening but that didn't wet the spirits that were flowing around the line as we grilled some steaks and listened to the old and new stories.

The recent rains had apparently tempered the range's infamous swirling

winds and the relatively mild conditions Sunday were just tricky enough to lull everyone into a lot of 4-and-1 patterns. The Heavy 200 was a tight race with Ernie Martin taking the small-group ball cap with a .267 on the very first target. Dave Hellekson's .313 in the second match helped him to a second place .2499, while Rod Brown's .353, and .383 in matches 3 and 4 helped him to the win with a .2326. Paul Holland's .489 was the top group in the fifth match and secured his .2590 agg for third place.

Intermission We like to engaged are our target crew during the inter-yardage break and set them up with some rifles. Travis shot Justin's rifle and his .299 almost took that small group hat from Ernie. Brandon and Joyce turned in a .504 and .790 to show they could have been playing with us all day.

The beautifully mild temperatures Sunday afternoon were offset with enough fast headwind switches that a .3 could go to an inch before that flags would show any hints. Rod Brown's small groups on the first (.399) and last (.500) targets let his .2725 climb to the first place slot. Justin's .518 on the second match also got him second in the agg with a .3438. Ernie Martin won his second small group ball cap with a .339 in the fourth match and took third

in the agg just barely behind Justin with .3840. Paul Holland's .454 in the third match was our other small group.

In the grands, Justin's commanding lead from the LV100 gave him top position in the LV Grand with a .2815. Second was Rod Brown with a .3208, and third was Ernie Martin with a .3563. Rod Brown took the HV Grand with a .2327, with Dave Hellekson taking second with a .2727 and Paul Holland rounding out the top three with a .2920. Winning three yardages also gave Rod Brown the lead spot on the Two Gun with a .2768, followed by Justin Young's .3157 and Paul Holland's .3253.

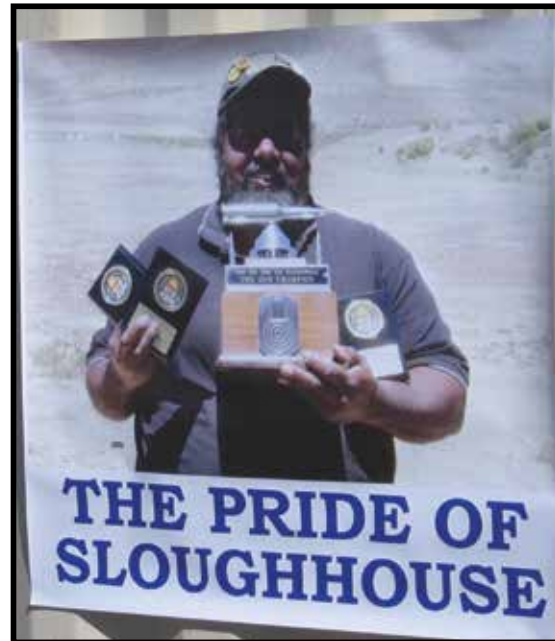

Tips & Tricks with NBRSA President Jack Neary

Wind Angle Effect – Calling Your Shot POI

For simplicity, I break-down wind angles into (8) different angles I pay close attention to the following angle conditions...

- 12 o'clock head wind
- 1:30 quartering head-wind
- 3 o'clock full-value cross-wind
- 4:30 quartering tail-wind
- 6 o'clock tail-wind
- 7:30 quartering tail-wind
- 9:00 o'clock full-value cross wind
- 10:30 quartering head-winds

Learn how each of these respective wind angles will affect the point-of-impact change on your record target and learn through much, much, much... practice, how to hold accordingly to complete your groups as quickly as you can, where possible!

Make it a practice to when you are shooting a sighter shot on your target, tell yourself where you expect the shot to impact for that given angle and wind intensity. With much practice, you will start seeing your sighter shot match your point-of-impact expectation!

The 2021 WA State/Ed Frombach 3-Gun was hosted by TR&RC over the Labor Day weekend and, once again, we all enjoyed the company of our BR community. This year's winner was Mark Walker, who put together another fine performance with his "Beast", which sports an all-aluminum stock and 2-piece skeleton forearm, in 6PPC. Throughout the weekend winds were moderate, even mellow at times, and the temperature ranged from 50 to 75 deg F.

Twelve shooters drew benches for Sporter Class on Saturday morning, under overcast skies. In the 100 yd agg Mark held the lead through the first 3 matches. 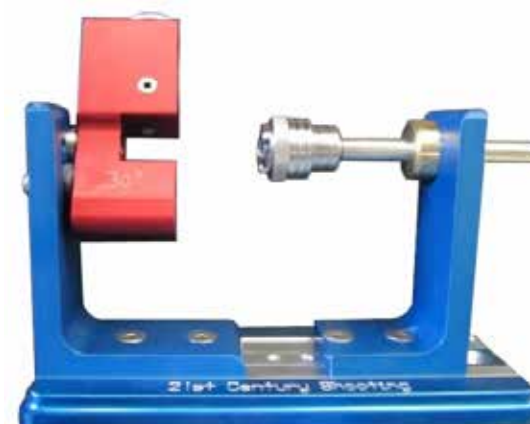
