## Gulf Coast Region Agenda Items:

Since the inception of Varmint for Score in the NBRSA, the scoring system has always been based on the best edge scoring system with the 1/2" "bullseye" as the highest score, (10) and the center dot representing an "X", only to be used as a tiebreaker. We feel that this scoring system is not a representation of not only the rifles' capability, but also the shooters' capability in his effort to keep his shots as close to the center of the "bullseye" as possible.

We are proposing that in NBRSA Varmint for Score the scoring system should be changed to include the center dot in the scoring system by making it an "eleven". This would change the concept of a perfect score to a "275", with 25 wipeouts. The wipeouts would become the tiebreaker.

We feel that this scoring system would be more in line with the NBRSA mandate of achieving extreme accuracy and precision, and more reflective of the actual best achievement by each shooter in the aggregate.

- 1) In NBRSA Varmint for score, to make the center dot score 11 points. This will make a new maximum score of 275 with 25 wipeouts. All other scoring criteria will remain the same. **Submitted by Jackie Schmidt**

3.6. Backers (Moving): A moving backer strip or card will be required for 100 yard, 200 yard, and 300 yard matches in all registered shoots. When the backer strip or card fails to operate at any range during a match, only the number of shot holes that can be clearly distinguished on the target will be counted to determine the number of shots on the target. It is the Match Director's responsibility to ensure moving backers function properly to capture all shots regardless of weather conditions.

Would like to amend the rule for the use of an electronic or acoustical backer system for the purpose of verification of record shots on targets. This amendment will be on a trial basis with results provided to NBRSA BoD for determination of feasibility as a permanent option. E backers track the number of shots electronically and acoustically, and are transmitted to the scorers computer.

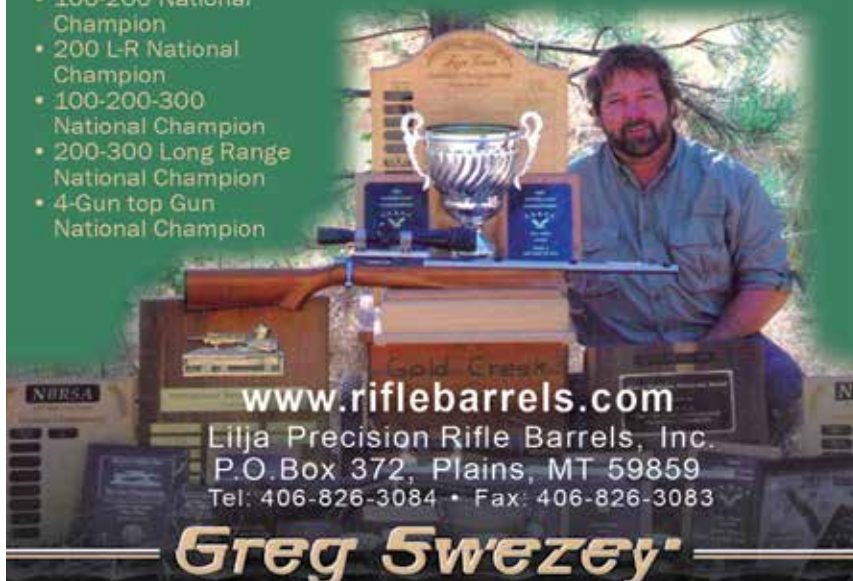

The Arkansas Spring 100 yd 4-Gun match is in the books. We had shooters from all the surrounding states. A very good crowd, indeed. The weather was exceptional. Rain and high winds were forecasted but never materialized.

Saturday morning dawned as calm as it has ever been at the Ouachita range. Not a tail moved in spite of high winds and storms in the forecast. Joe Hargadine put a whipping on the rail gunners with his bag gun. His 10-shot Unlimited .2584 agg was a sign of things to come. Dwane Stafford took second with a 10-shot .3028 and the Iron Man, Danny Morgan, was third with a .3046. # “Ready on the Firing Line...”

I've been fortunate enough to be able to shoot benchrest matches all over the country at some very large ranges like St. Louis and Phoenix, and some smaller ranges like WWCCA and Shelby County. One thing that is unique at each range is how the benches are constructed and how close to each other they are arranged on the firing line. As a left-hand shooter, sometime the width between me and the right-hander next to me is quite close, which brings into discussion this month's article on the impact of shooting at the same time, i.e., "Doubling". I remember when I first started competitive shooting some of the seasoned veterans would say to me go ahead and shoot your target, and I'll wait until you're done. I remember feeling concerned at times if I took too long to shoot. A shooter once doubled with me at the Eastern Regional Championship at Holton, and outspokenly ranted to everyone that it was my fault for his poor group size. I felt bad, until Lowell Hottenstein said, "Lee, don't worry about it. You have the right to shoot in the same seven minutes". Below are what several seasoned veterans have to say on the subject.

## QUESTION

**During a relay, would you typically wait for the guy next to you to finish their group if he started before you? Do you think there is an impact on doubling up?**

### Jeff Peinhardt

Conditions play into this process. If it's a trigger pull its super important to wait. If its blowing 15-35mph forget it.....not going to make much difference. I think we have all been burned with a "Double". .....it hurts. Typically, I try to wait for shooters next to me to finish their group if they have started first, if I must I will time shots between theirs. I think its most appropriate to discuss this with your fellow competitors and foster a process that will make the match enjoyable for all shooters near you.

### Jack Neary

Yes. Unless there is little time remaining and then I will try and shoot my shots in cadence after they shoot their record shots to prevent doubling with them. Do you think there is an impact on doubling up? Yes. It is caused by the flinch on the trigger during your firing sequence from the surprise of the shot on the bench next to you. This issue can be mitigated by wearing ear-plugs and also earmuffs, as some shooters will do with the goal of better reducing the gunfire noise around them...

### Gary Ocock

I don't wait just because they started. I most likely will wait if the shooter is on a record pace and I'm not. Yes, I think there may be an influence. I hold onto the gun and for the most part have not been able to identify any influence on my side.

### Harley Baker

Yes, I will try to be aware of shooters near me. depending on conditions and time, last two minutes it is everyman for himself. Impact on doubling; I think there are two issues to be aware of. First is the condition of the firing line and the benches, test to see if the shooter next to you moves your rifle when he shoots and second, I think if you are not totally focused on your shooting you will flinch on a "double".

### Donald Rosette

If it's my condition as well, I'll shoot and try to time my shots in between their shots. I'd rather not double up and cause a shot out or a flinch that could cause a shot out.

### Craig Rowe

Yes, if I think or know he or she is shooting better than me I will wait. Doubling has an effect.

### Greg King

Good or bad I'm usually done before others get stated. Then it calms down and I think I should have waited for that. I've seen it mess up a few groups if you double with someone buy it has to be the same exact second.

### Jeffrey Gaidos

It really depends on the day and the shooter aside of me. If the conditions hang around and the person shoots fast then I would wait. If it is a nasty day and you are shooting the same condition as your neighbor then you might only get one chance at a good condition and you have to shoot. If that is the case then I try to time my shots in between theirs, if possible. I have experienced doubling with a neighbor and have come out with a bad group doing that. I try to avoid shooting when they are, if possible. If I am not shooting well and my neighbor is shooting great then I will wait until they are finished. Especially if your neighbor is winning the two gun and it is late in the match.

### Joel Nader

I shoot sighters when I want and I go on record when I want. When I finish my group, I pull my bolt and you can have the remaining time all to yourself. If you want to shoot while I'm shooting it won't bother me at all.

### Victor Potts

Yes, if the fellow competitor next to me starts his group I will wait. If the conditions are dicey and getting low on time then I try to alternate. If you double with your neighbor, it's going effect you or him, and with my luck it's always me.

### Lee Hachigian

I never worry about doubling, and I normally pull the trigger when I believe the best condition is there for the taking. I do wear foam ear plugs in addition to my ear muffs, so my neighbor's muzzle blast doesn't impact me. I never forgot what Lowell told me, "... it's my seven minutes too". ■

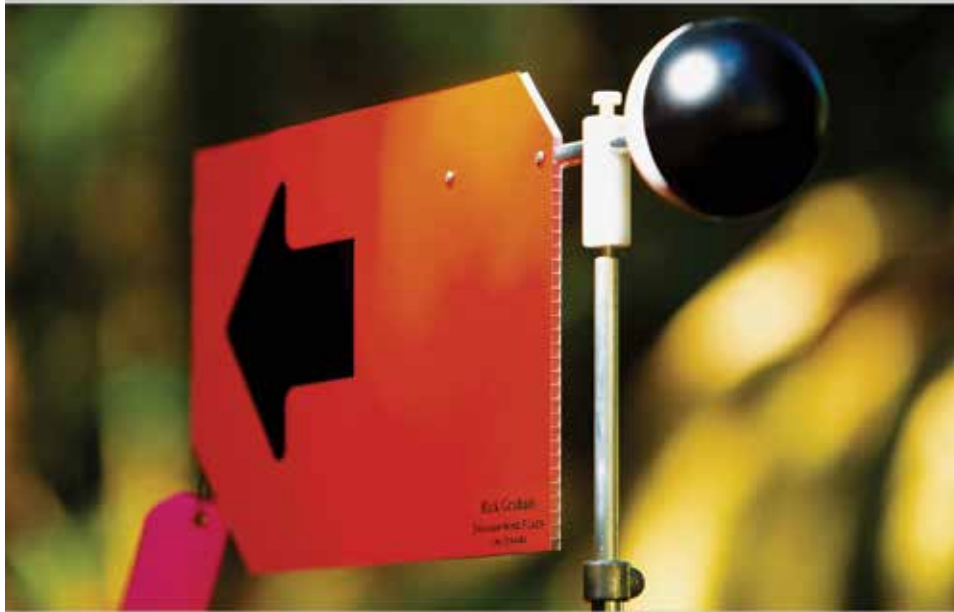
