It was very comparable to the 2017 Nationals in Casper Wyoming. Winds 25-40 mph with measured gusts up to 60. Nothing was spared from the winds. Flag poles were blown over, flags were broken, numerous things were blown off the benches, and no hats were safe. However, even with the horrible conditions, the loading shed was alive with laughter and good-natured ribbing.

Randy Robinett (IA) gave all the six power shooters a lesson at 100 with a 249-13X. To show how bad the conditions were, only one 50 was shot at 200 by Jim Franzen (IA). Jason Stanley (NE) managed a 233-2X at 200 to get the win at the Yardage and Grand.

April 24 was VFS. Mother Nature must have heard us complaining about the winds on Saturday, because she threw in the bonus of cold temperatures on Sunday. Same strong winds with the high of 45 degrees. Shooters were sitting in their cars between matches to warm up.

Dan Williams (IA) shot an excellent 250-15X at 100 to take home some wood. Dick Winchester (NE) showed us how to do it with the only 50 at 200 and the win with a hard-earned score of 236-2X. Stanley shot a 486-15X for the Grand and 2 Gun.

The true champions of this match were the match director and target crew. Rod Dewey, Jeff Shultz, Kent Kennedy, Ron TeSelle, Dick Winchester braved the weather. These gentlemen worked in horrible conditions, without pay, so that the competitors could shoot. Hats off to these guys. Literally.

As has been the tradition, the Eastern Region's short range group match schedule starts at the Western Wayne County Conservation Association in April, and this year was no different. What was different, at least from recent years, was the beautiful weather we were blessed with. Sunny, warm and no rain during the entire match. WWCCA welcomed 25 shooters from all over the Midwest and Canada.

Saturday's match started with 55 degree temperatures and around 65% humidity. As we finished up that afternoon it was 81 degrees and humidity down to about 43%. Winds were pretty steady right to left, at least from the left side of the range. This range has a tendency to produce some pretty squirrely conditions at times.

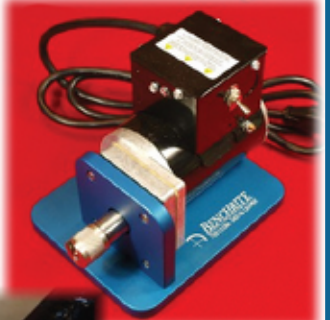

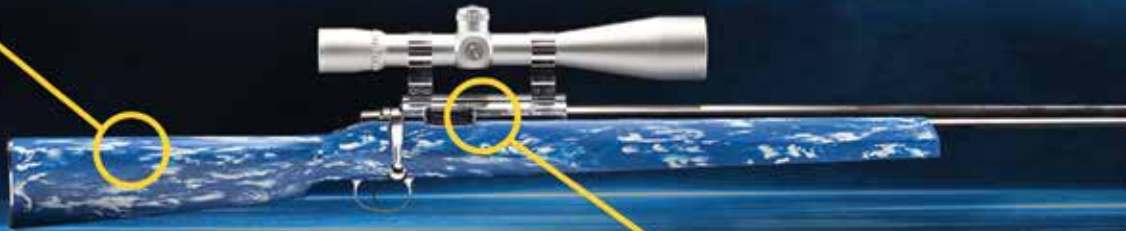

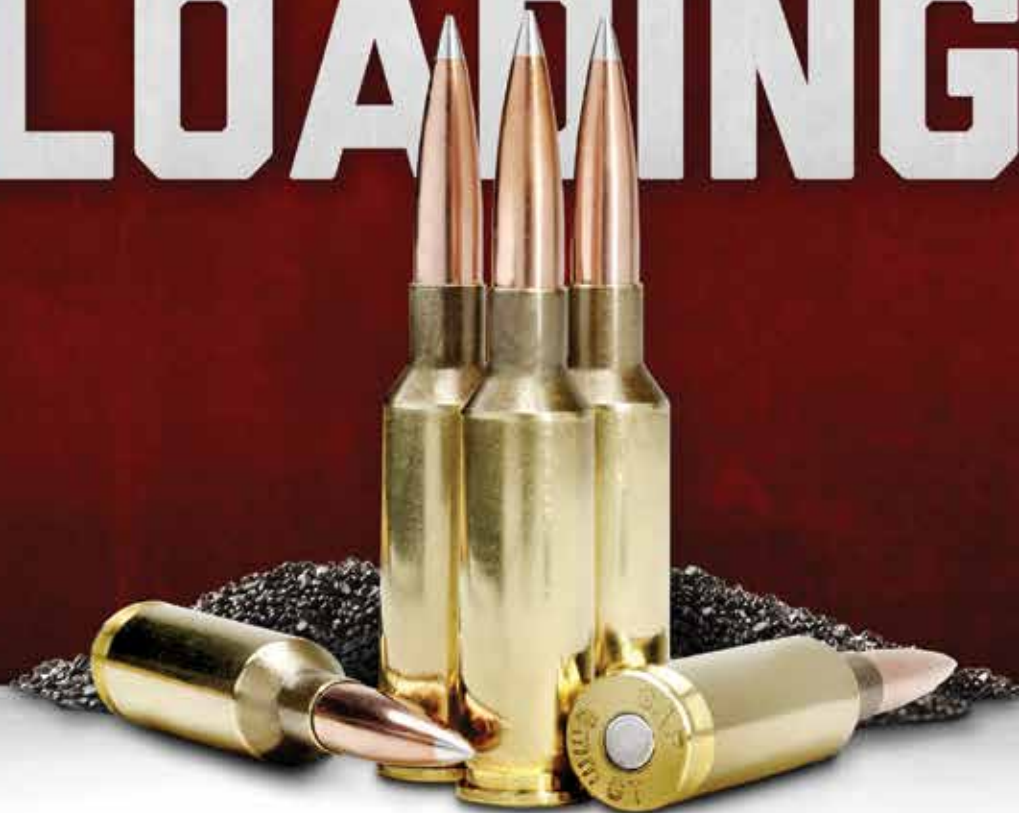

“Ready on the Firing Line...”

By | Lee Hachigian

Competitive benchrest shooters spend a lot of time preparing their brass to obtain utmost precision in overall length, primer pocket depth, and neck thickness. However, once we start using the brass at what point does multiple firings begin to have an impact on how well your gun shoots. I loaded next to the Gene Bukys for many years and I noticed that he always lightly chamfered his brass between targets. On the flip side, I only chamfered my brass after re-trimming the overall length. For many years I wouldn't use that brass on the record target until I shot it once on the sighter in fears the newly chamfered inside neck would impact seating tension and thus impact point. Below are what several seasoned veterans have to say on the subject.

QUESTION

How often do you chamfer your match brass (inside and outside the neck after sizing)? When do you do it (how many firings, between targets and/or during a match if necessary)? Do you have any apprehension on using this brass immediately on your record target?

Gary Ocock

I only do this after I've trimmed the brass to length.

Jeff Peinhardt

I trim my brass after every firing and also chamfer inside and outside each and every time. I think trimming/chamfering is critical to maintaining a finely tuned rifle during competition.

Jack Neary

I re-chamfer my case necks before every aggregate. I do not have any apprehension in using my cases with a fresh chamfer on the case mouth!

Harley Baker

I trim after every firing and chamfer after every trimming. Always shoot them on record.

Craig Rowe

Only after trimming.

Joel Nader

Only once after neck turning and then each time after trimming.

Greg King

I fire my brass 2 or 3 times before I shoot it in a match. After that ill trim to length chamfer inside and outside of the neck. Every 200 rounds or so ill repeat the process.

Donald Rosette

I chamfer my brass inside and out after turning the necks to their thickness. I'll do that again after I trim them to length usually about four firings. After that I'll inspect them while reloading if they look rough, I'll clean them up.

Jeffrey Gaidos

I will chamfer the brass after I trim it and if I think it needs it during a match. I normally trim the brass before a match and in the evening before the 200-yard portion starts for a two gun. I will use the brass on the record and do not have any apprehension about that.

Victor Potts

The only time I chamfer my brass is after it's trimmed to length. I check the case after an agg. to see if or how much it has grown. ■
