

he 2022 Cotton Boll shoot was held September 17 and 18 at the Llano Estacado Shooters Association Range Southwest of Lubbock Texas. We had a total of 27 shooters show up this year to compete in some challenging conditions. We shot both days in a very inconsistent switching tail wind ranging from 15 to 25 mph. Saturday morning we started with LV 100 yards, Everett Horner started with an impressive .183 and never let up, after the fifth target he was on top with a .2030 Agg. Close behind him was Speedy Gonzales with a 2084 and Steve Murphy with a .2126. After a lunch break, we resumed with HV 100 yards and the winds were definitely holding strong. Cody Engel started off with the lead with a .204 as the rounds continued going down range it became very evident that everyone was going to shoot at least a 3 or 4 tenths group whether they liked it of not. At the end of the match our very Steve Murphy had prevailed as the winner in spite of shooting a .343 and a .384 followed by the small group of the match a .158. Steve's Agg was a .2684 followed by Mike Conry with a .2732 and Speedy Gonzales with a .2786.

Sunday Morning we started with HV 200, the first relay experienced relatively calm winds but it didn't last long. Mike Conry started things off with a .303 and he never really showed any sign of letting up. On the second match relay one, Kyle Shultz somehow managed to sneak in an impressive .135 which stood as the small group. When the match was over, Mike Conry took the win with an impressive .1980 Agg, Cody Engel was second with a .2659 followed by Speedy Gonzales with a .2737. When the results were tallied, Mike Conry's 200 yard performance gave him the HV Grand with a .2356, followed by Speedy Gonzales with a .2762 and Cody Engel with a .2782.

After Lunch we resumed with LV 200, as the winds grew stronger so did the group sizes, Speedy started off with a nice .370 that was joined on the wailing wall with several inch plus groups. Eddie Harris Wins 2022 NBRSA SE Regional 4-Gun & 3-Gun! Andy Shifflett Wins 2-Gun!

Middle Georgia Gun Owner's Association in Dublin Georgia hosted the 2022 NBRSA Southeast Regional Championship September 22-25. MGGOA is the home of the Shamrock held every March for the last 21 years. Next year the Shamrock will be held March 25-26 2023. Y'all come shoot!

The Southeast Regional Championship is a 4 day, 4 gun mini-nationals. We shoot Unlimited and Sporter 200 on Thursday, Unlimited and Sporter 100 on Friday and run Saturday per the usual LV-HV 100 followed by HV-LV 200 on Sunday. This year the weather was beautiful all 4 days.

Thursday starting Unlimited 200 the wind was non-existent for the first couple of groups. Buddy Ross started strong shooting .356. In match 2 Steve Lee followed up his match 1 .363 with a .410 to take the lead. By match 3 the wind was starting to blow a bit and Wayne Campbell shot .370 to take the lead. Lots of big groups in match 4, but Wayne clinched the win shooting .474 in match 5. He won with an agg of .2337. Eddie Harris was second with .2773 and Buddy Ross finished third with .2921. Don Hardeman had small group with .322.

Thursday afternoon was Sporter 200 and conditions were very sporty! Andy shot .515 in match 1 squeaking by Wayne's .519. After his match 1 train wreck, Eddie Harris shot a nice .383 in match 2 followed up by very consistent 4's and 5's for the rest of the agg. Dana English was in the lead after match 4 despite having 3 6's (tells you what the conditions were like) but stumbled in match 5. Wayne Campbell won the agg with .3260, Eddie Harris was second with .3331 and Dana finished third with .3457. Eddie had small group with his .383.

Steve Lee was awarded NBRSA Southeast Region Shooter of the Year.





You still had to start at the right time and maybe you had to hold a bit to finish a group, but mistakes weren't as costly in this agg. Starting off the aggregate and shooting small group for match #1 was James Coulter with a nice .277. Winning matches 2 and 3 was Chuck Miller with groups of .393 and .432. Small group for match 4 a .270 shot by Dana Andrus. Shooting small group for the yardage and winning match #5 was Gary Ocock shooting a .179. 


