After another delicious lunch of grilled hamburgers and brats, it was time for the LV200 Aggregate.

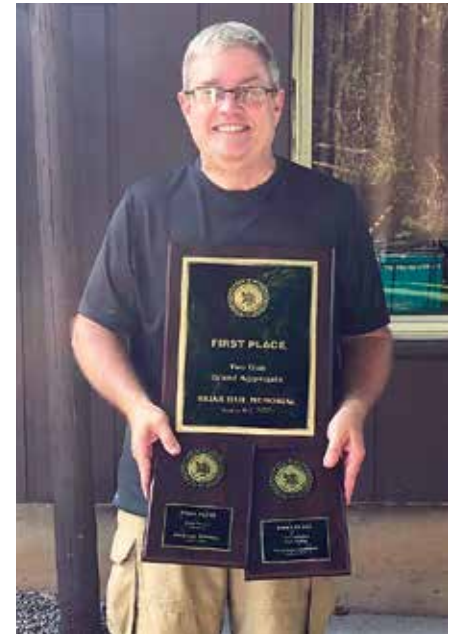

Paul Whitt won the LV Grand Aggregate with an impressive .1997! Glad to have you back Paul!

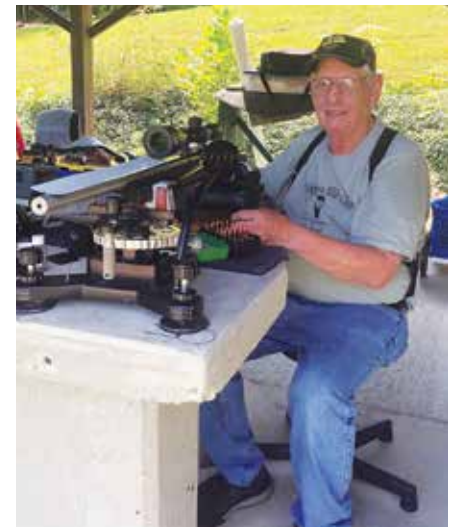

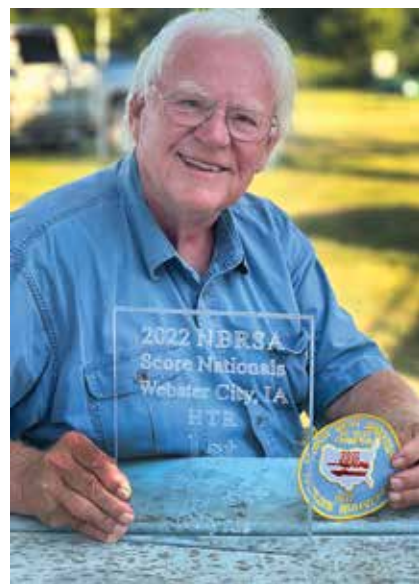

# “Ready on the Firing Line...”

The primary attribute of “benchrest” shooting is that the rifle sits on top a front and rear bag. How these bags are designed and how you set them up can have a large impact on the precision of your rifle and shooting capabilities. Front rest designs have evolved over the years from stationary to the use of joy sticks. The associated front bag designs and materials have also changed from high ears to low ears and primarily Leather to Cordura. Today, some manufacturers provide an option for “Super-Slick” materials and fabrics. This month’s question is about front bag tension, specifically, how tightly the front bag squeezes the stock. Below are what several seasoned veterans have to say on the subject.

## QUESTION

**On a scale of 1-10 (1 being loose and 10 being firm) what stock tension do you like on your front rest bag, and why? Do you ever change the tension due to conditions?**

### Jeff Peinhardt

I’m a 2 on front bag tension, I actually wiggle the stock from side to side then apply just enough tension to keep that from happening. I will often re-adjust after firing a couple sighters as the bag settles. If conditions are heavy or firing at an uphill range, I use a bit more tension.

### Jack Neary

I feel many shooters may have their front bag set-up where it’s just a little too tight which will drive you crazy with all kinds of lost stupid shots you cannot account for? I would say my front bag “tightness” rating is probably a “5”. I believe you want your rifle to recoil “freely” and... “smooth”, but never “Loose” where the recoil is too free and uncontrolled.

### Gary Ocock

My scale is around 5 to 7. I don’t want any wobble, no side-to-side movement. No change because of conditions. I might change because I’m using a slightly different stock.

### Harley Baker

My scale is around 5-6 on tension scale, I will change tension with conditions, especially if there is a lot of humidity.

### Joel Nader

I want my rifle to slide with medium smooth tension. I check my front bag often by wiggling the front end of the stock sideways back and forth, if there is any free play in the front bags, I will tighten down my ears just until it goes away. I don’t like a heavy squeeze up front. To give my desired tension a number, I would say around 5. I won’t change that tension regardless of conditions.

### Greg King

I would say about a 6 on my front bag. I don’t think I’ve ever changed for conditions.

### Craig Rowe

My scale is around 5. I want to feel a smooth transition. I only change this if another rifle is being used.

### Donald Rosette

I shoot over Cordura so I keep my front bag tension at a six and shoot free recoil. I’ll go to a tight leather front bag when I have to shoot up hill.

### Jeffrey Gaidos

My front bag is set so the rifle can move freely in the bag. I am always tweaking the tension to get it to what I like. I fluff my front bag before every aggregate and make sure the front bag is not hard (can cause vertical). I am not sure I can put a number on it. I will change the tension for the range. For example, when I shoot at Kane the range faces up hill and the recoil of your neighbor might start the rifle to slide back to me. In that case I will run a little tighter bag tension to avoid that situation. I won’t change bag tension for the conditions of the day.

### Victor Potts

Since I shoot free recoil, it’s snug. 6 maybe 7, I never change it. That’s funny Lee would ask this question; I never think about it.

### Lee Hachigian

My front bag is made with that super-slick material with high ears, and my back bag is Cordura. I would put my tension number on the front bag around 8-9, since the super-slick material never prevents the rifle from recoiling smoothly. I like it to be tight, so if I double with the right-hander next to me it will have little consequence. I asked this question of the guys above, because I typically shoot three different rifles for a match and I’m always adjusting front bag tension at the start of an agg. I just wanted to know what other shooters do. ■
