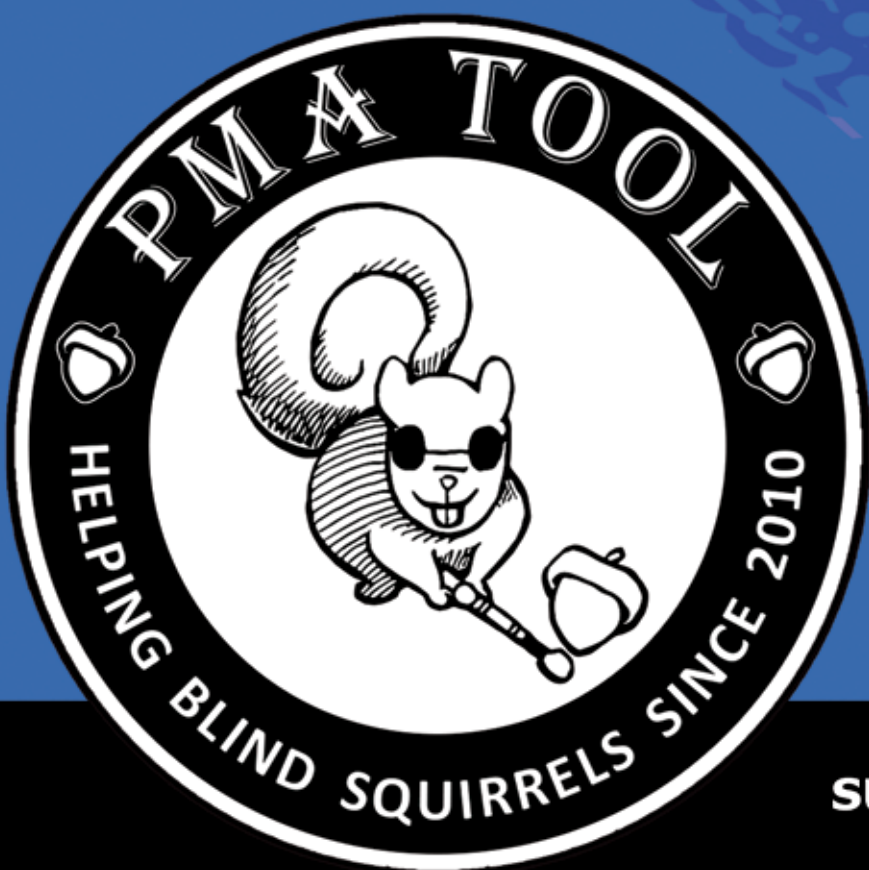

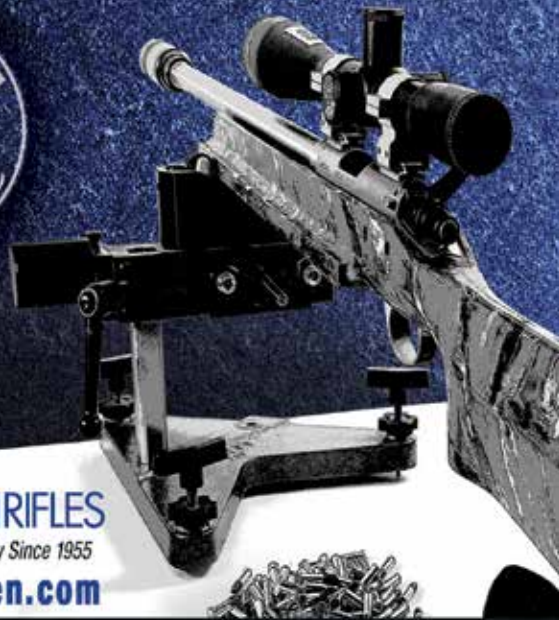

We had 25 competitors for the Missouri State Championship match which was held at Bench Rest Rifle Club of St. Louis on October 19-20. We started off Saturday clear and calm for the LV 100. First time shooter, Cole Jacobs, had a .107 for small group, and Jerry Wick won it with a .1986 aggregate. Dean Ekstrom took 2nd with a .2094 agg and Kip Jones took 3rd with a .2624 agg.

For the HV 100, Dennis Boyet and Max Margherio battled it out, but in the end Denis took 1st with a .2190 aggregate, followed by Max with a .2194 agg, and Dean Ekstrom with a .2472 agg. Small group went to Bob Hawkins for a .138. Greg King cleaned up for the UNL 100, getting a .125 small group and taking 1st with a .1816 agg. Leon Noel took 2nd with a .1944 agg and Kip Jones took 3rd with a .2372 agg. We finished off the day with a bit of socializing in the clubhouse and the much-anticipated steak dinner served up by our match director, Scott Pieper.

Sunday kicked off a bit cooler at 48° and despite less favorable wind conditions, Wayne Corley shot a .191 small group. J.J. 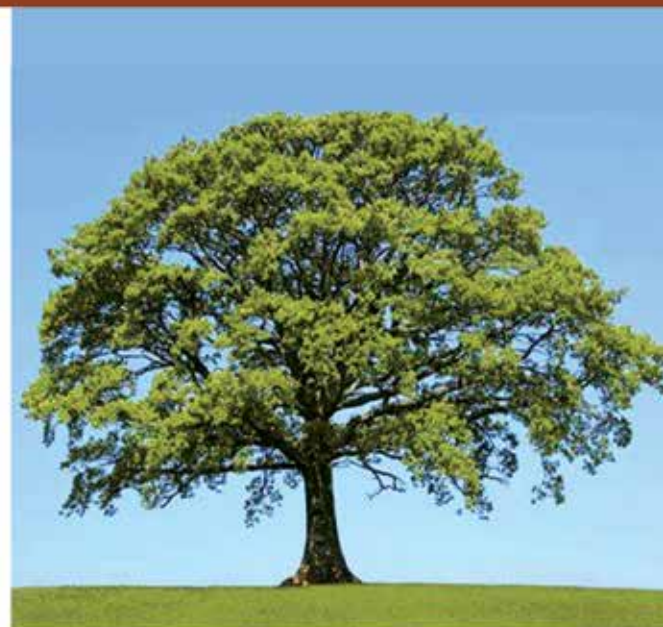

Notice to our members concerning the NBRSA Group Nationals Unlimited class

While it was an unfortunate situation, the NBRSA Board made a decision that the host organization, Arizona Benchrest Shooters, an entity that is owned by an individual(s) and not an actual club, must follow the rules of the association. They were notified of this decision by their Regional Director, Mr. Mike Sosenko. Various board members and other NBRSA members volunteered to help rectify the situation before the match started by helping get the targets and backers in order to follow the rotation rules but the host, controlled by Mr. Lou Murdica refused to allow this to happen. Since he refused the NBRSA BOD declared the Unlimited Class as unregistered class. While the host did allow the competitors to compete, a large number of competitors did not compete since it was an unregistered class but the host did award their range trophies to the ones competing. Since it was not a registered class of the NBRSA, the NBRSA BOD did not award their traveling trophies nor did they recognize a 4-gun winner. The NBRSA is allowing this part of the competition to be published out of respect for those who did compete even though it is not a NBRSA registered class.

We regret this issue but stand firm in enforcing the rules and bylaws of the association. Any member who would like to discuss this further, please contact your Regional Directors or Officers of the NBRSA. ■

Practice for the match started off Oct. 22, 6 days before the start of the competition. The shooting conditions varied from very mild winds (flag tails hanging straight down) to an occasional strong push. I was surprised how many out of town shooters showed up early for practice. Before the start of the first day of competition (UNLIMITED 100 yards) it was decided by the NBRSA regional directors not to register the Unlimited portion of the event because the host club didn't follow the rules of competition for Nationals registered competition. Briefly the host club thought rotating every other match instead of moving equipment for every match would satisfy the rotation rule. As a result the Unlimited portion of the tournament was a non registered competition.

We had 46 shooters start the Unlimited match; with many others not shooting for various reasons. Temps for the day were low of 74 and a high of 95. The wind was mostly manageable, however later in the match we had periods of 12 to 20 mpg gusts. Overall the shooting conditions were on the mild side for the Ben Avery shooting facility. Opening up with a .172 group and small group for that match was Lester Bruno. Very close was Ed Adams shooting a .174. As it turned out they were 1 and 2 in the aggregate as well. Lester shot a .2175 agg while Ed shot a .2217. Finishing in third place was Paul Weaver shooting a .2397. Paul was certainly helped shooting a .166 in his last match; that group turned out to be the small group for the Yardage. Of note was Jeff Peinhardt who finished in 15th place shooting a varmint rifle.

The 200 Yard stage shot 3 days later was shot in lighter winds with temps ranging 60 to 80 degrees. We shot the first group at 200 with the wind coming mostly straight at us (N to S). I've found that with that wind it's best to try and shoot with the wind straight at you possible avoiding if possible any angle direction, hard to do when you're trying to watch 7 or 8 flags. It seems that I managed that strategy best as I shot small group for that match and small group for the yardage a .245. In all honesty I probably had a little luck with that as well. Shooting a really nice 8 group, 10 shot aggregate was Al Auman Sr. with a .2596. In second place was Ed Adams who shot a .2911 aggregate. Al's aggregate was 31 thousands smaller than Ed's; a big difference. In third place was Lou Murdica shooting a .2913. I mentioned that Jeff Peinhardt shot one of his varmint rifles at 100 yards; he also shot it at 200 as well and finished in 5th place, shooting a .3097 aggregate.
